

**TWISTAR Supply List & Preparation** (2 pages)

In this quilt, there are four distinct stars that appear to be overlapping. In the sample photo, Star 1 is green, Star 2 is pink, Star 3 is blue, and Star 4 is red. There are five samples pictured in the Gallery on my website. Notice the different effects achieved with different fabric combinations. For best results, Stars 1 and 3 can be similar, and Stars 2 and 4 can be similar, but Stars 1 and 3 should contrast with Stars 2 and 4.

**Choose Fabrics:** (Makes Wall/Baby size, approx. 48" x 48")

You will need NINE different fabrics: four large-scale prints for the Star Centers (C1-C4), four small-scale prints for the Star Points (P1-P4), and one Background (BG) that will contrast strongly with the P fabrics.

Star Centers (Fussy cut motif or large-scale print)

C1:	Color 1	¼ yard or 1 FQ
C2:	Color 2	¼ yard or 1 FQ
C3:	Color 3	¼ yard or 1 FQ
C4:	Color 4	¼ yard or 1 FQ

Star Points (Small-scale print or tone-on-tone, *non-directional*)

P1:	Color matches C1	½ yard
P2:	Color matches C2	½ yard
P3:	Color matches C3	½ yard
P4:	Color matches C4	½ yard

Background

BG: Very dark or very light, read-as-solid ¾ yard  
(Buy an extra ⅝ yard of BG if you want to add a matching border to make the stars appear to float. Buy an extra ½ yard of BG if you want a matching binding.)

If necessary, we can spend time at the beginning of class going over fabric selection. If you are not sure of your selections, bring extra fabrics that you think might work as substitutes, and I will consult with you at the start of class.

## **Cut Fabrics:**

(Follow Step 2 on page 2 of the pattern, column two for Wall size.)

From each fabric C1, C2, C3, and C4:

Cut four 6½" squares

From each fabric P1, P2, P3, and P4:

Cut five 4½" squares

Cut twenty 2½" squares

Cut twenty 2½" x 4½" rectangles

From fabric BG:

Cut twenty-five 2½" squares

Cut sixteen 4½" x 8½" rectangles\*

Cut four 4½" x 6½" rectangles\*

\*Advanced: If using a directional background fabric BG, there are special instructions in pattern, so if you don't have the pattern, don't cut BG rectangles yet.

## **Bring:**

- Basic Sewing Supplies:
- Machine (with manual, foot pedal, power cord, needles, bobbins)
- Rotary cutter
- Mat
- Rulers: 8½" or larger square, 6"x12", or whatever you have
- Any tools you use to achieve quarter inch seam allowance
- Fabric marking pen/pencil
- If you have it, any ¼" marking ruler or tape (e.g tiger tape.)
- Medium value, neutral color thread that will blend in with your fabrics.
- Fabrics as described above, including pre-cut pieces *and* leftover fabric.
- "Twistar" pattern. If you have it, read through it before coming.
