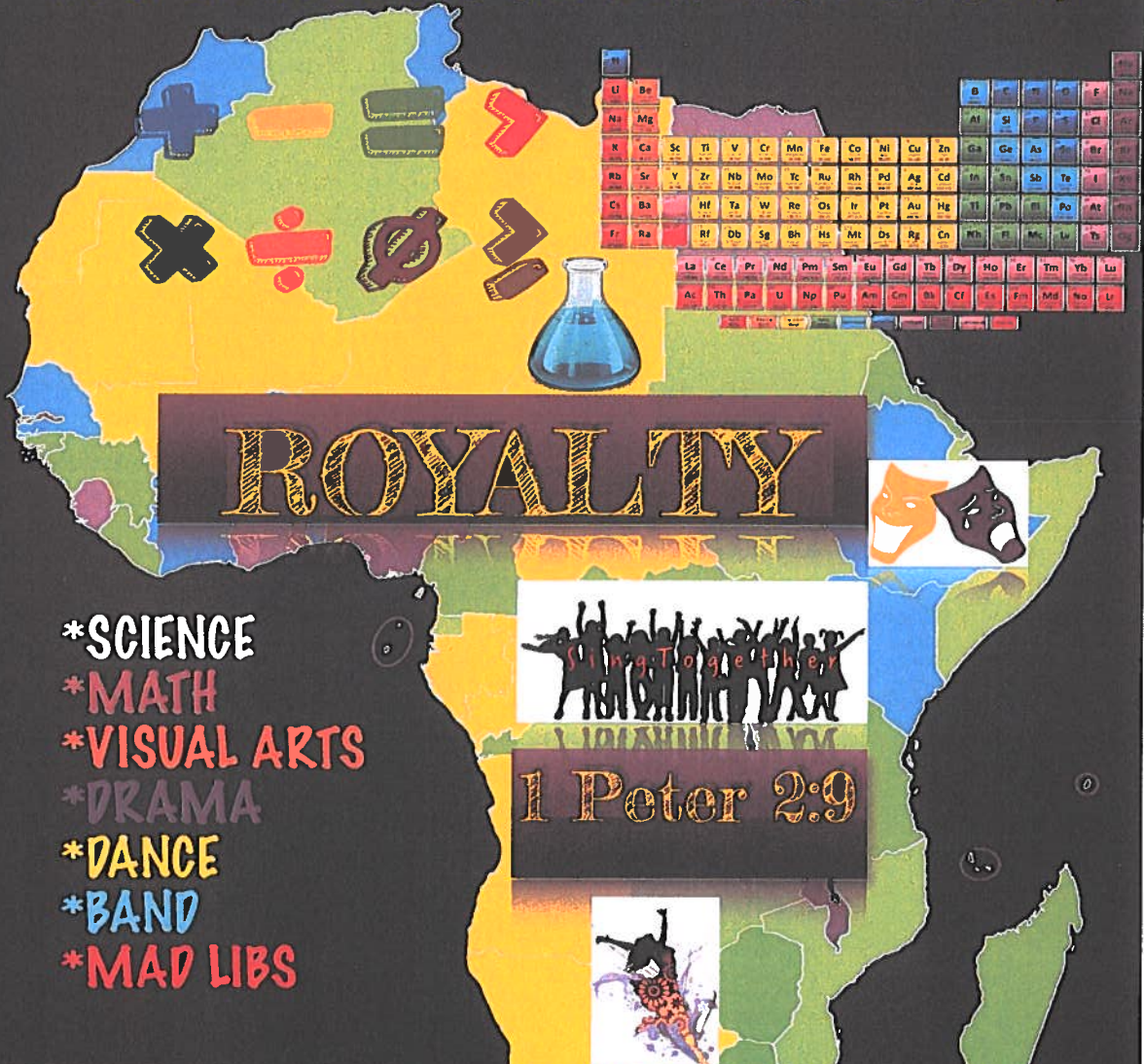


A Tribute To Mothers
