On June 16, 23, 30 and July 7, 2023, Belleview United Methodist Church hosted the second event to be held in Florida. During those four days, the pilgrims (the attendees) heard 14 talks, celebrated communion, sang, ate, laughed, prayed, worshipped, and shared the love of Jesus Christ. 21 pilgrims attended, 16 women and 5 men, including 5 from BUMC. More than 20 people served on the team. Some were table leaders; some cooked; some directed traffic; some greeted; some prayed; some set out snacks and coffee; some set up and took down tables and chairs. The pilgrims and team came from seven congregations. It was a wonderful event for all!
