



Bad Date Sheet – March 1, 2018

Shift publishes the “Bad Date Sheet” as a way for sex workers to share bad experiences and help protect each other. Reports are confidential and can be done anonymously. You can report online at www.shiftcalgary.org, or on our hotline number: (403) 237- 8171. Staff at Safeworks and Shift can also take reports directly and provide support to sex workers.

What is a bad date? A bad date is anything that you don’t want others to experience. This includes an uneasy or creepy feeling about someone, theft, refusal of payment, threats, and all acts of violence and aggression. *We often have additional information and reports that have not been published, please contact Shift for these details.*

Date: February 2018

Description of Event: The man refused to pay me and we got into an altercation and he tried to hit me.

Description of Date: 56-60, Caucasian, average build, brown eyes, Always wears a cowboy hat

Description of Vehicle: N/A

As Reported to: Shift website on February 27, 2018

Date: Jan 4, 2018

Description of Event: Worker passing out from using down and from exhaustion woke up and client was assaulting. Client was using a condom. Worker fought back by hitting/punching client. Able to leave date eventually, and did not pay for date. Also stole from workers purse.

Description of Date: 18-25, Aboriginal, over 6 feet, average build, brown eyes*

Description of Vehicle: N/A

Date: October 31, 2017

Description of Event: Worker was to meet a male client in Aspen Woods area (Calgary), but two men showed up at the building. Client then disappeared and harassed worker with calls from “Text Now” apps. He set up fake dates demanding location address, and no showed. Worker reported harassment to law enforcement.

Description of Dates: Two males, Caucasian, 18-25 years old, approx. 5’10”, one was stocky, baby-faced with short brown hair and glasses, the other was tall and lean with face tattoos.*

Description of Vehicle: N/A

As Reported to: Shift website on November 1, 2017

Date: October 18, 2017

Description of Event: Date booked an in-call with two workers for a 1-hour threesome service in Calgary. He had passed the application and reference process. Client was behaving erratically and eventually disclosed he was under the influence of a “large amount” of MDMA (ecstasy). Worker tried to “keep the peace”, but believes that both workers were exposed to the drug through the date and experienced unpleasant side effects as a result. The date eventually left after a stressful hour, leaving both workers to endure the remainder of the effects of the drug.

Description of Date: Caucasian, 5’11”, 36-40 years old, athletic built, blue eyes, short black hair with silver side burns*

Description of Vehicle: N/A

Date: October, 2017

Description of Event:: Date found worker on Backpage. Date called at all hours of the night and sent frequent texts despite being asked to stop. Worker repeatedly advised him to stop calling and harassing her, and other workers have reported similar experiences with this person. When asked to stop, the date “flew off the handle”, was verbally aggressive, and shaming of worker.

Description of Date: Male, “dark-skinned”, uses a text app. 587-437-**** (additional details available)*

Description of Vehicle: N/A

Date: September 13, 2017, 10:30pm

Description of Event:: Client arranged full-service date with worker via Backpage, they met at a location in NE Calgary. Date removed condom non-consensually during intercourse.

Description of Date: Black, 26-30 years old, shaved head with beard, brown eyes, slim build, 5’6 in height. *

Description of Vehicle: Took a taxi

As Reported to: Shift website on September 15, 2017

Date: August 18, 2017

Description of Event:: Worker met date at a motel in NW Calgary for a 3hr *BJ DATY* session. Date took worker to a residence in SE Calgary where she reports she was drugged with GHB and sexually assaulted at knife point for several hours. She was then dropped off at a NE train station while still very intoxicated and did not receive full payment.

Description of Date: Caucasian, 41-45yo, 185cm, athletic build with short light brown hair and scruffy face, blue eyes*

Description of Vehicle: White lowered pick-up truck, license plate # B_R_9_9

As Reported to: Shift website on August 31, 2017

Date: July 23, 2017

Description of Event:: Date met worker on Backpage for BBBJ service. Date picked worker up at her residence (NW Calgary) and refused to pay the agreed amount as he felt she wasn’t the same person as in her photos. Date then decided he did want services anyway but was abusive, forceful, and manipulative. When worker resisted assault, date kicked worker out of his car and she walked home.

Description of Date: 26-30, Middle Eastern, 5’8”, average build with brown eyes and stubble. Had English accent.

Description of Vehicle: Small 2-door car, with right hand drive. Dark color.
