## 4 Blocks Across and Down (16 total) = 46.5" Square Quilt <br> 5 Blocks Across and Down ( 25 total) $=\mathbf{5 8 \prime \prime}$ Square Quilt

## BLOCK ASSEMBLY

1. Trim the Outer Square Sashing strips and cut 2-3 $1 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6$ " and $2-31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{\prime \prime}$ rectangles.
2. Sew a $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6$ " rectangle to the left side and right side of a 6 Center Square. Press seams.
3. Sew a $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 12^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle to the top and bottom of Step \#2 assembled block. Press seams. The unfinished block should measure $12^{\prime \prime}$ square.
4. Repeat Steps 1 and 2 to make (16) blocks for smaller quilt $O R$ (25) blocks for larger quilt.

## QUILT ASSEMBLY

1. Arrange blocks across and blocks down to optional size of your liking. Sew blocks in rows and then sew rows together. Each finished square should measure $11 \frac{1}{2}$ " to make the above listed overall quilt top sizes. Press.

## FINISHING THE QUILT

1. The backing fabric is included in the kit, however, it will need to be cut and pieced together to fit the quilt top size selected. Suggested piecing method is either a) cut yardage lengths in half $O R$ b) cut along the straight of grain (perpendicular to the selvage) to make one continuous length. Then sew two pieces together to accommodate the width of the quilt top.
2. Layer backing, batting and the quilt top. Baste as desired. Quilt as desired.
3. Cut and sew $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ WOF strips into binding and bind the quilt as desired. Note: The $46^{\prime \prime}$ square quilt will use @ 194 " of continuous binding and the $571 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ square quilt top will use @ 240 " of continuous binding.
4. Add label.
