New Business:

- Norwealdmere Fund Moved Hilde confirmed with Kingdom that Norwealdmere has given notification of closing. The money from this fund was moved to the general fund by unanimous vote by all present.
- **Add Kingdom Exchequer to Bank** Account as Signatory - In order for Kingdom Exchequer, Aesa Gilsdottir aka Angie Gilmore, to become a signatory on the bank account as required by Society of Creative Anachronism: Kingdom of Northshield, Policy Item 18, Subsection C, it was motioned, voted on and approved during this business meeting. This will allow meeting notes to be brought to Community First CU in order to add her to the checking account without being physically present.
- **Brown County Library Ren Faire They** are in the planning stages for Saturday June 3rd, 11am - 3pm. Interested in armored combat, dancing, jewelry, equestrian, etc. Discussions of Equestrian possibilities and concerns were brought up. Concerns include that there might not be enough space as well as there would need to be a waiver signed for all attending the faire for insurance purposes.
- Baronial Herald Election Lord Edmond stepped down as Herald. A few members mentioned possibly being interested but no one was willing to be voted in at this time. Baroness Markéta has volunteered to be Baronial Herald Pro-Term.
