The City of Key West is conducting a Climate Vulnerability Assessment to assess future climate threats such as sea level rise, storm surge, heavy rain, high tides, extreme flooding, heat, wind and etc.

This project will finish with a community prioritized 10-year Climate Adaptation Plan that identifies projects, budgets and grants to prepare the City and its residents for future climate hazards.

There are public outreach meetings and surveys throughout the project which will help with data collection, flood mapping, modeling, critical asset evaluation, and City policy updates.


