## **CACAGNY Outraged at Carranza's Latest Racial Antics**

Race-trafficker-in-chief Education Chancellor Carranza is at it again.

Unbelievably, the man who commits explicit anti-Asian bigotry just added anti-Asian bigotry to his implicit bias training for Department of Education staff.

This is, after all, the man who smears Asians that they think they "own" admissions to Specialized High Schools, while he pursues policies that seek to exclude large swathes of Asians from these Schools.

This is, after all, the man whose DOE uses code phrases such as "schools that don't look like the City" to disparage Asians for not having the right look.

This is, after all, the man whose DOE sponsored the Center for Racial Justice in Education that declared that Asian Americans "benefit from White Supremacy" by "proximity to White privilege."

This is, after all, the man who conspicuously took no disciplinary action against a widely protested CEC 22 member who dismissively referred to Asians as "some ... yellow folks."

This is, after all, the man whose DOE summoned force to block Asians -- and only Asians -- at the entrances of a schoolhouse from within which he personally ran a "public" Town Hall.

To have Carranza run training on anti-Asian bigotry is like having the KKK run training on anti-Black bigotry.

And to have Carranza exploit anti-Asian bigotry to legitimatize his implicit bias training so that he can further traffic in narratives of white supremacy and toxic whiteness is insulting to Asians.

Anti-Asian bigotry is a serious problem for Asian Americans, not to be used for such exploitation. The first step for the DOE to address anti-Asian bigotry in NYC is to get Carranza out of NYC.
