

# EMERALD WALTER FAHRNER

## 1905 - 1997

Emerald Walter Fahrner, 91 of Auburn, formerly of Pigeon and Caseville, died day, July 4, at Bay Shore Nursing Center, Bay City.

He was born Dec. 3, 1905 in Kilmanagh, son of the late William and Maude (Utcher) Fahrner.

He and Elaine Marguerite Staubus were united in marriage in Pigeon. Mr. Fahrner and his wife owned and operated Fahrner's Men and Boy's Clothing and Fahrner's Appliance Store in Pigeon until 1955. He was employed in sales at C. F. Farm dealership, Pigeon and later at Sebewaing Motors retiring in 1962. That same year they moved to Caseville. He then operated his own advertising sales business until the present. He recently moved to Auburn, nearer his son for health reasons.

He was a member of Auburn United Methodist Church and past member of Pigeon United Methodist, Pigeon, Caseville United Methodist Church and the Pigeon Lions Club.

Surviving are his wife Elaine; two sons, Ronald (Leatha) Fahrner of Auburn and Lynn (Charmaine) Fahrner of Cass City; four grandchildren, Ronald, Kathy, Tim and Michelle and six great grandchildren, Chad, Krista, Morgan, Kaitlyn, Jonalee and Jillian.
