

## **Pool Rules**

By use of this facility the Resident(s) and/or their guest(s) agree that they have read, understood, and will abide by the following rules. All dues must be current for use of pool.

**A GUEST IS CONSIDERED SOMEONE THAT LIVES OUTSIDE OF THE SUBDIVISION. A NEIGHBOR WHO HAS NOT PAID DUES IS NOT A GUEST.**

Pool hours are from 8 a.m. through 9:00 p.m. daily, unless otherwise noted.

1. In case of emergency dial 911; Emergency Telephone is located between the restrooms.
2. If you are at the pool and someone asks you to let them in, DO NOT do so and tell them they will need to contact a HOA Board Member.
3. **SMOKING AND VAPING IS PROHIBITED** inside the fenced pool area. Please stand at a distance of 25 feet from the pool perimeter. *Smoking and Vaping are prohibited at our playground amenity.*
4. The use of abusive or foul language is prohibited within and around the fenced-in pool area.
5. **NO LIFE GUARD ON DUTY – SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK.** The HOA will not be responsible for anyone's valuables or injuries.
6. Owners with non-swimmers in their charge are responsible for watching these non-swimmers at all times. A parent or responsible person 18 years or older must remain with children while they are at the pool. Children 5 years and younger must have a parent or adult 18 years and older in the pool with them.
7. Children who are not 13 years old must be accompanied by an adult who is at least 18 years old. A Board Member or authorized person can ask for ID at any time.
8. Swim suits must be worn at all times. Children must also wear swimsuits. Infants who are not toilet trained must wear an official swim diaper when entering the pool. Regular diapers are prohibited. Cut offs are not permitted.
9. **NO GLASS BOTTLES, GLASS CONTAINERS OR OTHER BREAKABLE** containers may be brought into the pool area. **NO BEVERAGES OR FOOD MAY BE CONSUMED WITHIN 4 FEET OF THE POOL EDGE.** All trash must be discarded in the proper receptacles.

10. All RESIDENTS, children, and guests who utilize the pool and its facilities are expected to conduct themselves in a reasonable and respectful manner. RESIDENTS are responsible for the conduct of their children and guests. NO DIVING, Anyone who behaves in a manner which is disruptive, inappropriate or disrespectful of others (including but not limited to running, pushing, shoving, dunking, spitting, etc.) may be asked to stop. If such actions do not stop, the person(s) may be asked to leave the pool area immediately. Warnings and requests to leave can be made by any member of the HOA. The HOA Board requests that RESIDENTS report the incident in writing to them within 24 hours. If violations continue, pool privileges will be revoked. 11. Persons having an infectious or communicable disease, which can be transmitted by water, shall be excluded from the swimming pool. Persons with blisters or cuts shall be warned of infection and advised not to use the pool

12. Pets are not permitted in the pool area at any time.

13. No chewing gum is permitted within the fenced area of the pool. Gum will damage the pool pumps.

14. There is a 4 guest per member limit per family. ANY GROUP OF MORE THAN 4 GUESTS PER MEMBER CONSTITUTES A PARTY. A WRITTEN APPROVAL FROM THE BOARD IS REQUIRED IN ADVANCE AS LARGE GROUPS IMPACT USE OF THE POOL BY OTHER RESIDENTS.

15. ALL residents should assist in the enforcement of the rules and regulations. Belfaire HOA Members should report any issues to the Belfaire HOA Board. Contact information is located next to the phone.

16. Pool use privileges may be suspended by the Board of Directors of the Belfaire Homeowners Association. *Codes to the pool area will not be issued to a resident unless all dues are current.*

17. The pool area is not to be used for large parties. Please reserve the pavilion if you are having a party.

18. No grills are allowed inside the pool area.

19. Pump room is off limits to unauthorized personnel.

20. The gate must remain closed at all times and are not to be propped open. No resident, child, or guest should let anyone in the pool area if they are told the person forgot or lost the code. This can result in the resident losing pool privileges.

21. A First Aid Kit is located in each restroom
