Her eyes started to brim with tears, she became a bit abrasive, at which point I invited her to step into our office to speak more privately. She seemed relieved and once we were in the shelter of a quiet room, the floodgates opened. This precious young woman was at a breaking point. She explained how she has a medical condition that essentially causes connective tissue in the body to break down causing excruciating pain, easily dislocated joints, and a myriad of physical torment. This is awful stuff. She explained how it takes every bit of strength and literally several hours to prepare a meal for her daughter; she has to be extremely careful of opening her refrigerator door as she has dislocated her shoulder doing so in the past. Making matters worse, this young mom has no one in her life who she can count on. Her mother died years ago, her father is absentee, and her brother who lives with her has a newfound drug addiction that is creating an increasingly horrific living situation. Her daughter seems to be slipping away as she struggles to provide for her and be available for the "normal" duties of a mom. My heart broke under the crushing weight of this poor girl's daily fight. She can't pay her bills. She can't stir her oatmeal. She can't carry groceries in. She can't hold down her job anymore.


