Public Presentation 1 Watershed 1 Plan

Three years ago Lake and Cook counties set out on a bold new initiative to work together to manage their Lake Superior North watershed, a pioneer project in the state of Minnesota. Now they are hosting public presentations to share what they have learned.

One Watershed, One Plan is the name of the project that was adopted by Lake County and Lake County Soil and Water Conservation District, along with Cook County and Cook County Soil and Water Conservation District.

The plan targets and prioritizes areas for land and water management in the whole of Lake Superior North watershed, which combines the two counties into one big watershed picture, rather than two separate entities has been the goal.

The four government units have a memorandum of agreement that they will collaborate on certain tasks in the plan, and many landowners and other partners have been involved in the planning over three years.

Focusing on protection and restoration efforts, the transition from separate county management to a single watershed management plan is anticipated to offer advantages, including: resource management beyond political boundaries, systematic conservation planning, and better collaboration with larger landowners.

Informational sessions that are open to the public are being held in both counties: Wednesday, October 23rd from 6:00 pm to 7:00 pm at the Cook County Courthouse in Grand Marais, and Thursday, October 24th from 6:00 pm to 7:00 pm at the new Lake County Highway Department building (1513 Highway 2) in Two Harbors.


Funding for implementation of the plan was received last year through the Board of Water and Soil Resources and the Clean Water Fund. More funding for tasks outlined in the One Watershed, One Plan are being pursued.
