A MESSAGE FROM PASTOR ROBERT.....

Brothers and Sisters in Christ.

It is with great sorrow that I must say goodbye, This past month after many conversations, and a lot of prayer, my family and I have decided to move to Portland, OR. This decision was made after Patrice was offered a position directing the Oregon Newborn Screening Laboratory. As many of you know Patrice is currently the Co-director of the Wisconsin Newborn Screening Laboratory so this position offers her a step up from her current position. This is an amazing opportunity for her and the girls and I couldn't be more proud of her many accomplishments leading to this opportunity to finally be able to have a lab of her own. Patrice starts her position on February 1st so we will be moving west not long after the beginning of the year. As a result my final Sunday leading worship with the people of Burke will be December 26th.

As many of you know I was born and raised in the Portland area so this represents a return home for me. Yet even though everything is not back to "normal" as we struggle to figure out what "normal" is now, there is a deep well of faith, hope and love in this building. Today when I look at Burke I see a family, a deep loving family that is very dedicated to their church and their community, and it makes me proud to have been able to share this call with you all.

As I move forward in my career, wherever it may lead. I will always look back at my time here at Burke with fondness and love. Each of you have taught and sup-

ported me in many different ways. In particular I would just like to give thanks for those who have really put in the extra effort to support all of you and myself through many ups and downs.
