ORDINANCE NO. 328

AN ORDINANCE prohibiting cruelty to animals, and providing for penalty for violation.

DEFINITIONS: In this ordinance, unless the context or subject matter otherwise requires:

- 1. "Animal" includes every living animal except the human race.
- 2. "Cruelty" or "torture" includes every act, omission, or neglect whereby unnecessary or unjustifiable pain, suffering, or death shall be caused or permitted.
 - SECTION 1. No person shall torture, cruelly beat, neglect, or unjustifiably injure, maim, mutilate, or kill any animal.
 - SECTION 2. No person shall deprive any animal over which he has charge or control of necessary food, water, or shelter.
 - SECTION 3. No person shall keep any animal in any enclosure without exercise and wholesome exchange of air.
 - SECTION 4. No person shall abandon any animal.
 - SECTION 5. No person shall willfully instigate, or in any way further, any act of cruelty to any animal or animals, or any act tending to produce such cruelty.
 - SECTION 6. PENALTY: Any person knowingly and willfully violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a Class B. Misdemeanor, punishable by a fine not to exceed \$500.00, or thirty (30) days in the County Jail, or both.
 - SECTION 9. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force and effect from and after the $\underline{4}$ day of March $\underline{1985}$.
