From the President......

Neighbors,

As we end summer and head into fall, I wanted to share a NextDoor posting by Chris Culberson, security director for Fleetwood West.

We continue to be fortunate as the criminals have been busy elsewhere. While I know this is due in some part to our collective efforts, history reminds me eventually a bold (or ignorant) criminal will visit us. This is a reminder to not grow complacent and continue keeping an eye out for each other. For example, three or more of the following traits combined should raise your awareness.

- · An unfamiliar vehicle making multiple drive bye's
- Vehicle lacks the 1" square yellow Fleetwood ID sticker in the rear window
- · Vehicle has a paper temporary or rear license plate
- · Vehicle has very dark tinted windows
- Time frame between 10:00 am to 3:00 pm or 2:00 am to 4:00 am

I suggest that if you observe three or more of the above vehicle traits combined with a gut feeling something is not right, don't be shy about calling 911. Please also alert your security petrol at: 281-224-3048. Finally, please never confront or follow suspicious persons or vehicles. Just note from a safe distance the time, along with vehicle description, and email those details to fwsec@comcast.net or post themon: http://fleetwoodneighborhood.nextdoor.com and let our subdivision perimeter video surveillance system do the rest

As we move into the summer months, I am happy to report we have not had any reportable crimes in Fleetwood. Please continue your diligence and report any suspicious activities to Houston Police and Security Patrol. If we do not feed the criminals, and watch out for each other, I hope we can continue to have a safe and secure place to call home. Thanks again for all your efforts to keep Fleetwood safe!


I am currently reviewing the damaged areas of the alleys to get bids for repairs. We will do our best to address the most damaged areas first.




Memorial Drive Reconstruction Project is scheduled to start October 2015. This will be an approximately 27 Million project. The project will start construction at Memorial /Kirkwood and go west to Dairy Ashford and will take approximately 24 months to complete. The proposed plans are to improve intersections, improve pedestrian safety, add medians, to accommodate bike lanes and metro bus, add sidewalks, add new storm sewer to replace ditch lanes. Once the City has confirmed all details they will publish a final layout. 
