Tournament News

We had 10 players tee it up in the February tournament, which does double duty. First of all, it's a regular individual low net tournament. Secondly, it serves as the qualifier to seed our annual match play event – the El Prado President's Cup. The top 16 in each flight are playing in a 64 player single elimination tournament, once a week until they lose a match.

In the regular tournament, the only runaway winner was Don Yurgans, who cleared his D flight competitors by 4 strokes, drawing the attention of several members – we're watching you now! We paid out \$4300 to 50 different players. Remember, the more players, the bigger the scrip payouts and the cash pots. After only 5 tournaments, the Top 25 list is already impressive! Where will we be in September?

Our recent membership growth made the qualifier a lot more interesting. Just a few years ago, we only had 63 players, so everyone qualified. Now we are back to the true spirit of the qualifier – if you want to play match play, you need to play good enough to qualify, at least for one day (3).

Match play has started, and this year we are using GolfGenius to track the progress, instead of updating our own bracket chart. Find the results and your next opponent just like you would the results of any tournament or skins game. The rules were handed out and emailed to all participants, and are always on the web site on the Rules page.

As we remind you every year – some match play rules of golf differ from stroke play. Be sure to brush up on the differences, and be kind to new members who are not familiar with match play. Check your rule book, or download the USGA rules app from here or the web page. Just last Saturday a rules question came up, and I pulled out my phone and got the answer in seconds with the search function. Much easier that flipping through the book for me, but you can use either.

If you are in match play, be sure to **contact your next opponent to set up your match as soon as you can**, and if you have any issues contact Doug. If you can't play your match, you may need to forfeit – no hard feelings!

March's tournament is the Member/Member, and it happens **early – March 5**. This is a 2 man team event with mixed formats. For example, last year we used best ball and aggregate, but the board will decide for sure the week before the tournament.

Signups for a guaranteed spot in the tournament close Saturday February 26, or Tuesday March 1 if we have room. Remember, once we commit our tee times with the course, the rest of tee sheet sells out, so no more adding tee times later in the week. Please sign up EARLY by emailing Doug at dbenc@ap.org. We will publish the roster of signed up players on the Wednesday before the tournament, and release pairings by Friday.

Getaway Signups are Open!

Finally! It's time to sign up for the El Prado Getaway May 13-15 in Laughlin.

The entry form with all the information is available in this newsletter, on our web site, and I will have hard copies around the golf course. Rules News - Wood Chips

We have recently had a lot of questions, and some misinterpretations, about the wood chips found around the course. First, a reminder of what our local rule states:

Wood chips spread as ground cover, including small mounds, are *loose impediments*. **Wood chips** in piles for storage or that have not been spread out are *ground under repair* and the player may take free relief under Rule 16.1b.

So what does that mean? First, you need to determine which of the two situations your ball is in.

If the tree trimmers have been dumping truck loads, and your ball is among the piles or their equipment, then it lies in *ground under repair*. Rule 16.1b describes your options for free relief in detail, but basically you find the nearest point of complete relief, and drop within one club length, no nearer the hole.

However, let's say the mulch was dropped a few days ago, has been spread out, and will be left that way as part of the course. In this situation the wood chips are *loose impediments*, even if there are small mounds. If the grading (spreading out the chips) is complete, then there is no free relief. The definitions and Rule 15.1 describe the details, but in summary you may remove the wood chips around the ball, as long as the ball does not move, you don't build a stance, and the chips are not stuck to the ball or embedded in the ground. This may allow you to create a clear path for the club to strike the ball. If you really want to take a drop, you have the option to declare the ball unplayable, and proceed under Rule 19 with the appropriate penalty.
