Early ballots will be mailed starting October 7, 2020.

They need to be mailed back no later than October 28, 2020 <u>and received</u> by the County Recorder before 7:00 PM on Election Day, November 3, 2020.

The Post Office WILL NOT forward your ballot. You must ask the County Recorder to do this. Please submit your request ASAP.
