**Position Posting:** The Town of Bridgton is accepting applications for a full-time year-round position in the above Division. The employee works under the general supervision of the Public Works Director. **Water District Test Results:** The Bridgton Water District has forwarded their 2012 Consumer report results to the Town regarding the water testing. This will be posted in the outer lobby of the Town Office for public inspection for the next 60 days. It appears that the District water supply passed all of the parameters tested for but did not test for Radium 228. For more information contact the District at 647-2881.
