Dennis was a founder and original member of the King Midas and the Muflers. He began playing both drums and guitar at an early age, however; influenced by the sound of early Memphis soul music and Jimmy Smith's organ, he found his calling in keyboards and studied with the famous keyboardist Mike Finnigan.



Continuing as a current member of the King Midas Band as the keyboardist and a vocalist, he was still performing and touring with other groups throughout Kansas as well. It all started in 1965 and he has continuously been rocking the midwest for forty-seven years. In 2006, 'King Midas and the Muflers'


