

Reminder: Daylight Savings ends on November 5th. Don't forget to set your clocks back 1 hour!

The Learning Tree now has the option to enroll in ACH auto-debit to pay your tuition payments. You can join anytime by contacting the office to request the enrollment link.

SCHOOL WILL BE CLOSED on Friday, NOVEMBER 10th for Veteran's Day, and on Thursday, NOVEMBER 23rd & Friday, 24th for THE THANKSGIVING HOLIDAY. If you know that your child will not be attending during any of the days that we are open during the week of Thanksgiving, please let the office know ahead of time so that we can plan our staffing.

Christmas daycare this year will be December 18th – January 1st (Closed Dec. 25 & 26; Dec. 29 & Jan. 1). This will be <u>daycare only</u> (meaning loose play, some combined classes and possibility of no structured rotations or regular school day lessons as some students & staff may be off for the holiday break.) We ask that you sign up and specify which days your child will be attending. *There is no tuition break for non-attendance*. The sign-up sheets will be hanging by the fish tank in the foyer towards the middle of November, so please sign up before Nov. 22nd. There will be a sign-up sheet for each week of daycare. Please check "yes" or "no" for your child's attendance and sign with your initials. Children may only attend their regularly scheduled days and <u>MUST</u> be signed up in advance to attend. If you don't think you'll make it into the school, and/or you have other people do your drop off or pick up, you may also email us with your child's daycare attendance schedule instead of signing up on the Sign-Up sheet.

As the weather starts getting cooler, please make sure your child has a sweater or jacket in their cubby to wear. We typically stay outside in the afternoons as long as possible, so please make sure the kids have things to bundle up with when it gets chilly. Please remember that we do not have jackets/extra clothes to loan out.

We have had some of the neighbors call and complain about our parents exiting the parking lot unsafely. This has resulted in a near collision on a couple occasions. We understand everyone is in a hurry to get where they need to go, but please be safe. Please make sure that you are looking before you make the turn out of the parking lot. With cars being allowed to park on both sides of an already narrow street, please look carefully before pulling out and exit with caution.
