We haven't spoken in such a long time, I would like to update you on things around here and if you would like to share any of it with others, you are welcome to do so. Let me start by saying WOW. I am looking back even just in the three years since this Jesus Freak group of bikers "crashed" my ASM graduation and I can say that God has moved in amazing ways ... There have been many ups and downs and many struggles I have had to overcome. After being told I could never have custody of my bi-polar son, Jon, God granted me custody last year. He is doing AMAZING. He is in football and doing wonderful in school. He has friends and is stable with his meds. We don't have traditional resources, such as insurance, AHCCS, etc. to get him help and for a long time I struggled with that. "How will I be able to provide the care and stability he needs? I can't do this! I need a doctor for his prescriptions, what will I do?" Time and time again I have poured my heart out to the Creator of the Universe and I have found Him ever so faithful. Long story short, we have a REAL doctor who does his labs and physicals and scrips for little or no cost ... God provided! We have been granted 2 YEARS of free medication from Abilify, THAT IS \$25,000.00 IN MEDICATION ABSOLUTELY FREE ... God provided! During a very bad time we had to go to ER at Phoenix Children's Hospital. God gave me three bonuses in three weeks that completely overturned that debt ... God provided! In the meantime I had the opportunity to be an Along Side Mentor to one of our young ladies who had fallen away into the dope life again. I had the extreme pleasure of placing her well-earned crown upon her head ... God provides blessing upon blessing!

So you are thinking this is so wonderful, right?

Let me tell you that appearances can be so deceiving. All this time, my God is meeting me at every turn, being so faithful and so loving, and every day I found myself becoming angrier and more depressed. Hating my life, wishing I could take it all back and just be a loser. This is hard to explain, but it started with the failure to control my temper. I have been praying and BEGGING God to help me not be so easily inflamed by people and situations. Over time, I have seen all the leaves of that particular habit of anger stripped away, providing SOME relief but leaving me with the trunk and root of the problem ... a consistent, nagging failure, leaving me depressed and faithless. Is this my thorn, Lord? To never be kind and gracious? To always yell and scream at my children or be rude and condescending in my job on the phones? Surely, He cannot be pleased with this. He isn't being honored, and He isn't getting glory. This anger is CANCELING OUT all the good testimony that surrounds my life.

So, one day I am working on the phones and found myself in a screaming match with someone yet again. Two days later I am working and get a message from the boss to log out and come to the office for a meeting. I was devastated. I knew I was going to be fired and I knew that I deserved it! I felt so helpless and hopeless. I wanted to run away. I was just going to email my resignation so I wouldn't have to face the humiliation of my guilt in person. I wanted to end my life, because in my mind this was just never going to get better. This cursed attitude problem!

I wept at the feet of Christ, all day and all night. I went to the office for my meeting, face and eyes puffy and swollen and heart-broken, I sat down and was granted ONE MORE chance. Oh my most gracious and merciful God! I do not deserve this chance. I went home suspended for the week and so grateful, but still in despair. How can I possibly NOT fail? I WILL fail. I will become angry and rude because in spite of God's supreme graciousness I still have this leafless tree that is sticking out of my front yard. Except now there is the noose of failure attached to its branch and it is so high and unattainable that I will for sure not be able to remove the impending threat of sure failure. I prayed all day and worried all day. I decided to go to Bible Study that night. We read out of the book The Peacemaker by Ken Sande, chapter 5 talks about idols. We all know what idols are, right? So I am thinking this doesn't really apply to me. And then the speaker started to read from James 4: "What is causing the quarrels and fights among you? Don't they come from the evil desires at war within you? You want what you don't have, so you scheme and kill to get it. You are jealous of what others have, but you can't get it, so you fight and wage war to take it away from them. Yet you don't have what you want because you don't ask God for it. And even when you ask, you don't get it because your motives are all wrongyou want only what will give you pleasure." So, I am sitting there and asking God, "What is it that I am wanting so badly that is causing me to be so abrasive?" The speaker came to a part in The Peacemaker book that stated when a good desire becomes an all-consuming focus, it becomes an idol. She started reading things off for examples, she came to the word "respect" and God took over my mind. He took that one little word and said THIS is your problem. He showed me example after example from the time I was a teenager until now that the desire to be treated with dignity and respect is the root of my anger issues and that it has become an idol in my life. Then He went on to say to me from James 4, "You adulterers! Don't you realize that friendship with the world makes you an enemy of God? I say it again: If you want to be a friend of the world, you make yourself an enemy of God." What do you think the Scriptures mean

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when they say that the spirit God has placed within us is filled with envy? But He gives us even more grace to stand

against such evil desires.

As the Scriptures say, "God opposes the proud but favors the humble. So, humble yourselves before God. Resist the devil, and he will flee from you. Come close to God, and God will come close to you. Wash your hands, you sinners; purify your hearts, for your loyalty is divided between God and the world. Let there be tears for what you have done. Let there be sorrow and deep grief. Let there be sadness instead of laughter, and gloom instead of joy. Humble yourselves before the Lord, and He will lift you up in honor. Don't speak evil against each other, dear brothers and sisters. If you criticize and judge each other, then you are criticizing and judging God's law. But your job is to obey the law, not to judge whether it applies to you. God alone, who gave the law, is the Judge. He alone has the power to save or to destroy. In Christ, Believe It By S.B.

There has been a lot of opposition on this yard; surprisingly from the brethren, but it is okay because I know it's the Spirit of Christ Who makes the Truth be known. (*Galatians 1:10-12*) We know that the law, even our old sinful nature, understands "the law – get what you deserve". But it is the Holy Spirit that helps us understand, "GRACE – get the good you don't deserve." It's time for us to be transformed, not self-disciplined, not self-righteous, but completely changed by the renewing of our minds, by believing who the Lord says we are IN HIM we are. (*Romans 12:2, 2 Corinthians 5:17*) Be changed by beholding the glory of the LORD, which is full of GRACE and TRUTH. (*2 Corinthians 3:18, John 1:14*)

"Come to Me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you REST." (Matthew 11:28) Don't spend so much time trying to fight the sin; spend more time strengthening the spirit (the seat of knowledge, the conscience), which then governs the soul (mind, will and emotions), which govern the flesh; which is the FRUIT brought forth of the nourishments from the ROOT (conscience, seat of knowledge –spirit).

Praise God for His Amazing Grace towards us IN CHRIST; may the Lord give you revelation. (*Galatians 1:10-12*) I am against sin; we are against sin. (*1 John 3:5*) AMEN! Sin is the transgression of the law, and we are also become dead to the law by the body of Christ. (*1 John 3:4*, *Romans 7:4*) Therefore, sin shall not have dominion over you: for you are not under law, but under Grace. (*Romans 6:14*)

Our old man (Adam's sinful nature) is crucified WITH CHRIST. (Romans 6:6) "For we know that since Christ was raised from the dead, He cannot die again; death no longer has mastery over Him. The death He died, he died to sin once for all; but the life He lives, He lives to God. In the same way, count yourselves dead to sin (noun- the thing, not the verb-action) but alive to God IN CHRIST JESUS." (Romans 6:9-11)

I encourage you to read these words of Paul's very carefully. If it's your first time reading *Romans 7:14-25* you might want to draw the conclusion that Paul may be using his sinful nature as a cop out. As you continue reading you will see in *verse 24*, Paul referring to himself as a "wretched man". Paul is not referring to himself as a piece of crap! He knows that he is human and still lives in an earthly body, of which, still wages war against the New Spirit in him. This word 'wretched' comes from two different Greek words that simply mean, Paul realized that during his misery, affliction and calamity he was in the middle of a battle. Like Paul, we too are tested and walk through trials that will lead our faith to being strengthened as we press in to reach the other side. And even though Paul asks the question, "Who will rescue me?", you will quickly see this was a rhetorical question. Paul not only knew the answer but he shared it with us as well when he said, in verse 25, "Thanks be to God, Who delivers me through Jesus Christ our Lord!" It is NOT God that tests or tempts us in any case! God HAS ALREADY given us His strength to walk through ALL things; by FAITH, we MUST begin to realize that we are IN CHRIST JESUS!!

Now then it is no more I that do it, but the sin that dwells in me (that is, in my flesh). (Romans7:17-18) While we are in this corruptible body (1 Corinthians 15:53-57), God wants us to exercise our faith by doing perfect in our conscience (Hebrews 9:9, 14, 10:2, 14); we walk by faith; not by sight. (Romans1:17)

Let the precious Blood of Jesus Christ purge your conscience of sins (*Hebrew 10:2*), for your sinful nature has died WITH CHRIST, and you have been BORN AGAIN into the Righteousness of God IN CHRIST; you are a New Creation IN CHRIST JESUS; in God's sight you are perfect, blameless, holy, righteous, complete, a child of light, in Whom there is no darkness (*John3:3*, *Galatians 2:20*, *2 Corinthians 5:17*, *21*, *Colossians 1:22*, *2:10*, *Hebrew 10:10*, *14*, *1 Thessalonians 5:5*); this is God's Grace established IN CHRIST JESUS. (*Hebrews 13:8*)

The TRUTH is: there may be sin in our performance, but there is No sin in our position. There may be sin in what we do, but there is No sin in who we are. Yes, there may be sin in our conduct ... but there is NO SIN in our relationship with God! PRAISE JESUS!! Exercise thyself unto godliness (1 Timothy 4:7), holding faith and a good conscience. (1 Timothy 1:19) Be transformed by the renewing of your mind. (Romans 12:2) "And herein do I exercise myself, to have always a conscience void of offense toward God, and toward men." (Acts 24:16)

I believe that this is some blessed food, right here, so chew on it, savor it, meditate on it, pray over it and be blessed by it.

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Foot's Bible Study Motes

1 Samuel 5:1-9:27

Today, many people don't respond to Biblical truth until they experience pain. Are you willing to listen to God for truth's sake or do you turn to Him only when you are hurting? (5:6-7)

How easy is it for us to complain about our problems, even to God, while we refuse to act, change, and do what He requires? We don't even take the advice He has already given us. Do you ever feel as if God has abandoned you? Check to see if there is anything He has already told you to do. You may not receive new guidance from God until you have acted on His previous directions. (7:2-3)

Often we let other's values and actions dictate our attitudes and behavior. Have you ever made a wrong choice because you wanted to be like everyone else? Be careful that the values of your friends or heroes don't pull you away from what God says is right. When God's people want to be like unbelievers, they are heading for spiritual disaster. (8:19-20)

At times, we think events just happen to us, but as we learn from this story about Saul, God may use common occurrences to lead us where He wants. It is important to evaluate all situations as potential "divine appointments" designed to shape our lives. Think if all the good and bad circumstances that have affected you lately. Can you see God's purpose in them? Perhaps He is building a certain quality in you or leading you to serve Him in a new area. (9:3)

John 6:1-42

If we offer nothing to God, He will have nothing to use. But He can take what little we have and turn it into something great. (6:8-9)

Faith is a mindset that expects God to act. When we act on this expectation, we can overcome our fears. (6:18-19)

We can satisfy spiritual hunger and sustain spiritual life only by a right relationship with Jesus Christ. (6:35)

Jesus said He would not lose even one person whom the Father has given Him. Thus anyone who makes a sincere commitment to believe in Jesus Christ as Savior is secure in God's promise of eternal life. Christ will not let His people be overcome by satan and lose their salvation. (6:39)

Psalms 106:13-48

In the wilderness, the Israelites were so intent on getting the food and water they wanted that they became blind to what God wanted. They were more concerned about immediate physical gratification than lasting spiritual satisfaction. They did not want what was best for them, and refused to trust in God's care and provisions. (*Numbers 11:18-35*) If you complain enough, God may give you what you ask for, even if it is not the best for you. If you're not getting what you want, perhaps God knows it's not in your best interest. Trust in His care and provision. (*106:13-15*)

Israel constantly turned away from God. How could they turn from God and worship the idols of the land after the great miracles they saw? We also have seen God's great miracles but sometimes find ourselves enticed by the world's gods ... money, power, convenience, fame, sex, and pleasure. As Israel forgot God, so we are susceptible to forgetting Him and giving in to the pressures of an evil world. Remember all that God has done for you so that you won't be drawn away from Him by the world's pleasures. (106:34-39)

Proverbs 14:32-35

Those with understanding hearts are where you can find wisdom stored. You will never find wisdom among fools.

Godliness and those who follow God can only make a nation better, whereas sin will only make a nation worse.

holds, I use it every day. That's what keeps satan off my back and gets me back on my purpose to do what He wants me to do. I will tell you as you start this adventure in prayer, you will have to be on your guard every day for the rest of your life; satan doesn't rest, he never sleeps, he is constantly on the attack.

You see in *Ephesians* regarding the armor, if you don't use the Sword of the Spirit (the Word of God), then satan doesn't mess with you. Many Christians I know can't do this; they think it's a waste of time. Quiet time that includes no reading, nothing ... just being quiet and still. Don't take my word for this; let me give you the Word on it ... *Psalm 46:10*, "Be still and know that I am God." Isaiah 30:15, "... In quietness and confidence will be your strength ..." There is power in being quiet and still and you can bet satan will do everything he can to disrupt your quiet time, if you let him, don't let him. Speak the Word, you have the authority to, God gave it to you, speak what God speaks.

I don't want you to take my word on this, I want to show you from the Word of God, just how powerful prayer really is and how much satan wants to prevent us from using this powerful weapon. Go to *Matthew 26:36-46*, this is where Jesus is in the garden of Gethsemane with His disciples praying. If you study the word Gethsemane in the Greek it means oil press, some translations say a place of pressure. I can't tell how much pressure Jesus had went through except it says He sweated great drops of blood. Jesus, who before the foundations of the world, knew He would come to this place of trial and testing, still was exceeding sorrowful and grieved, the pressure was so great that the disciples couldn't even stay awake, why? Overcomer's Cestimonies

I have a long testimony, in order to not bore every one; I will have to give you the Readers Digest version.

I was born July of 1957 in Nebraska to an unwed mother. My father was a farmhand who later in 1960 married my mother. I grew up in what is considered as the panhandle of Nebraska, a rolling prairie of sand hills covered with prairie grass ... cattle country. This area is often referred to as God's country due to its meandering streams and hidden lakes in the prairie lands. Sounds like the perfect American ideal life, huh? So, how did I get so far away from the cowboy, prairie, hay bales and feeding cattle lifestyle to being a three time convicted murdering ole biker?

I've been in prison since 1974 and have close to eight years left before I am released. This means that I have lived the majority of my adult life in prisons from Nebraska to New Mexico (where I caught a life sentence from the results of a riot there) to Arkansas, and then to Arizona. In 2002 I was released from prison, less than 6 months out and I picked up what is now my 3rd murder conviction. I am currently doing this time here in Arizona, again.

I have no immediate family left as they have all passed away while doing all of this time. But, I do have a large family of Christian brothers and sisters worldwide ... although most of you do not know me personally; we're all God's children ... that's a fact! My mother passed away at the age of 37 from sclerosis of the liver, a closet drinker for her times. She drank herself to death as a functioning alcoholic. My father, an alcoholic as well, drank himself to suicide on the highway. My father passed out at the wheel with me in the car, and hit another vehicle head-on in 1964. Three adults were killed; I was the only survivor of that accident. For the most part I was raised by my mother. She passed away when I was 14 years old. Still living in Nebraska when mom passed, I was then shipped to California to live with my grandparents. By the time I was 15, I was full blown addicted to heroin. To support my heroin addiction, I stole cars and cut them up in a chop shop. At the age of 16, I was eventually caught and sent to the California county jail. I eventually ended up in a treatment center there in California that is until I escaped back to Nebraska. It wasn't long and I was arrested there at 18 years old. Landing myself in a men's reformatory there in Nebraska I received 1-3 years.

While there behind those walls, I killed my cellmate and found myself on death row. From there on I was raised by murderers and death row inmates for the next three years. I eventually escaped from those walls which led to a nationwide manhunt. Due to the nature and boldness of my escape (1979) America's Most Wanted got involved. Through a series of escapes in New Mexico, Illinois and Arkansas, I piled on numerous new charges. In 1998, I was paroled to Arizona on my charges of auto theft. There on the theft charges ... five years later... and I was eligible for parole on all of my life sentences in Nebraska and New Mexico while still on parole from Arkansas. In 2002, I won all of my paroles and was released.

After I was released I met a great woman that had five kids. I started my own business and thought that I would settle down. Needless to say it was only a short while before my past began to chase me down. I took yet another life in an unlucky blow to a man's wind pipe. Needless to say I left there and moved on. While on the run from Arizona I was arrested this time in Oregon with new charges and was returned to Arizona as a wanted man.

There I sat in the Holbrook county jail. After catching more charges for socking up a sergeant there I felt like there had to be more to life and hit my rock bottom. I wrote a letter to a buddy of mine, Jim, who I knew was a Christian. I felt there were no other answers for me so I asked him to explain God to me. Certain circumstances kept Jim from coming to visit me but he sent a great gift from Christ, a brother by the name of Mike. Mike brought me to the Lord right there in solitary confinement in the Holbrook county jail. My life has since been turned around and the Lord has amazing grace for me. Currently, I have the greatest Gift that no man can ever take from me..., I have the Lord and His Spirit in my life. — A.M.

Cory's Corner The Meaning of Worship

I know that when I'm engaged in worship my body is full of the Holy Spirit. Sometimes it's all I can do to bring an offering to the Lord, being me in worship mode. What I'd like to do is share with others ... the Meaning of Worship ... hoping that they too will be filled with the complete holiness and satisfaction of understanding what it means to just bring yourself in worship to the Lord and the great righteous feeling it brings. Not to mention how it brings joy to the Lord.

"Give to the Lord the glory due His name; bring an offering, and come before Him. Oh, worship the Lord in the beauty of holiness." – 1 Chronicles 16:29

Worship refers to the honor and praise given in thought or deed to a person or thing. The Bible teaches that God alone is worthy of worship. (*Psalm 29:2*) But it also records accounts of those who worshipped inappropriately ... people (*Acts 14:8-18*), false gods (*2 Kings 10:19*), images and idols (*Isaiah 2:8*), heavenly bodies (*2 Kings 21:3*), and satan (*Revelation 13:4*).

True worship involves at least three things and important elements:

Reverence - This includes the honor and respect directed toward the Lord in thought and feeling. Jesus said that those who worship God must do so "... In Spirit and truth." (John 4:24) The term Spirit speaks of the personal nature of worship. It is from my person to God's Person and involves the intellect, emotions, and will. The word truth speaks of the content of worship. God is pleased when we worship Him, understanding His true character.

Public expression - This was particularly prevalent in the Old Testament because of the sacrificial system. For example, when a believer received a particular blessing for which he wanted to thank God, it was not sufficient to say it privately, he expressed his thanks publicly with a thanks offering. (Leviticus 7:12)

Service - The words for worship in both Testaments originally referred to the labor of slaves for their master. Worship especially includes the joyful service which Christians render to Christ their Master. The concept of worship involves much more than church attendance once or twice a week. It involves an entire life of obedience, service, and praise to God.

Take time everyday to worship the One and only Christ Jesus, Lord of Lords, thanking Him because His death was the ultimate expression of His love for all of us. (1 John 4:10)


