### Required Materials:

- Plastic water container
- Paper Towels
- #4H, #4B pencils
- Small Sketchbook, 5x7 or smaller
- Water
- Kneaded eraser
- Palette with mixing area & wells
- Masking tape
- Cut Sponge

### Brushes:

- ¾" flat watercolor brush
- #8 round brush

### Papers:

- 2 pieces of 140 # Cold Press paper approximately 9 x 12" ea. OR a watercolor tablet or block.
  - Don't buy cheap paper.
  - You will need some type of backing board (like gator board) to put the cut paper on.

**Paints:** Try to buy either Holbein, Windsor/Newton watercolors or M. Graham.

### Tubes

- Cadmium yellow light hue
- Viridian green
- Cerulean blue
- Alizarin crimson
- Ultramarine blue (sometimes called French Ultramarine)
- Olive green
- Cobalt blue hue
- Cadmium red light hue
- Yellow ochre

Please feel free to bring any additional watercolor supplies or paint colors you like and may have acquired from previous watercolor classes and workshops.
