BRANCH MEETING October 21, 2020

At 1945 President Keith Kaider convened an informal meeting with 6 members present including NC Paul Gunther PRPEC Randy Phillipp, Jr. Past President Thomas Rauch, Shipmate Ralph Freibert (Zoom) and Shipmate Mark Allen (Zoom).

The meeting started with discussion and approval of the September Minutes. Shipmate Gunther made a motion to approve, Shipmate Phillipp seconded and all approved.

Next on the agenda was the Report of Committees. Youth Activities, Shipmate Kaider spoke with Captain Kelly the Gaithersburg High School NJROTC Commander and they are willing to work with us for providing a Color Guard for our Pearl Harbor Ceremony if needed. Plus, the NJROTC will be having a small Veterans Day Ceremony that President Kaider will be attending.

Hospitals, Welfare, and Rehabilitation, Shipmate Phillipp reported that he sent a Get Well card to Shipmate Clark Murphy and his wife. Plus, he was notified that Jr. PRPEC Sha'ron Martin was not feeling well and also sent a Get Well card to him as well.

Shipmate Kaider reported that as of October we have 82 members, five for renewal and one that is past due.

Pearl Harbor Day Ceremony, Shipmate Gunther reported that he is working with the Walter Reed National Military Medical Center Chief Petty Officer Association and everything is on track to hold the ceremony in the Memorial Auditorium at Walter Reed on Monday, December 7, 2020 (Time is tentatively 1000, needs to be confirmed).

Shipmate Rauch went over the September Financial Statement and supporting reports and audited by Shipmate Phillipp. Shipmate Phillipp reported on the 2019-20 audit of the Treasurer Reports and made a motion to accept his report, S/M Rauch seconded and all approved.

Shipmate Rauch went over the October FRA Membership Newsletter from Headquarters, which will be distribute with this newsletter via email. Also, reviewed the FRA 2nd Quarter Membership Report.

There was no Old Business to discuss and continued to New Business. First, the National Officer Results, the new National President and National Vice President are Michael "Mick" Fulton (Br 289) and James Campbell (Br 40), respectively. Also, NC Paul Gunther was appointed as National Chaplain for another year. Congratulations!

Second, Shipmate Rauch discussed the Branch Standing Rule 5 for Continuous Member Pins, where a member can request a pin for their 5, 10 and 15 year anniversary that would be purchased by the member. A member can then also request a pin for their 20 year anniversary and every 5 years after that at the Branch's expense. Shipmate Rauch motioned that instead of at a member's request the Branch will automatically purchase and present the membership pin starting at the member's 20th year and every 5 years after that. This would exclude the 50, 60, 65 and 70 year anniversaries where National purchases the pin. Shipmate Allen seconded and all approved.

Shipmate Rauch also motioned to purchase the continuous membership pins needed for this Branch year that is not already in our inventory. Cost will be \$78 out of the \$130 we have budgeted for pins. This was seconded by Shipmate Freibert and all approved.

Third, the next CLC Meeting is October 24, 2020 @ 1400 via Zoom.

Fourth, the Veterans Day Ceremony in Rockville will be on-line only.

Fifth, there was discussion about the Branch/Unit Christmas party and it was decided to hold off due to the COVID-19 restrictions. Hopefully, we can hold a party along with our Installation next June.

Good of the Order was held and then at 2025 a motion was made to adjourn the meeting, seconded and approved.


