
### A Little Farther....




Congratulations, Ben Trettel. Ben has enlisted in the United States Marine Corps.



## Crocheting/Knitting Group for a Cause





**Opening:**

Sherry Petrosky opened the meeting with prayer.

**Minutes:**

The minutes for August meeting were sent electronically and approved. Jane Koch made the motion to accept and Gary Reynolds seconded.

**Financial Report:**

Jane Koch sent the August financial reports to all via email. She noted that on August 5<sup>th</sup> the 8:30 service was not counted and deposited until September due to the fact the money was left on the altar under the offering plates.

Pledges are down about 15% and Financial Committee hopes that at least 10% will be recovered by the end of the year. Don Brooker made the motion to approve the reports and Sandee Davis seconded and the motion passed.

**Pastor's Report:**

Pastor sent his monthly report electronically for our review the day before the meeting.

**Old Business:**

Things are moving along with all the programs this year. The Stewardship program, "A Little Farther," will begin September 23<sup>rd</sup>, with the thought of paying down the debt, and will continue throughout the year. The program will be explained to the congregation with the amount of the debt. Pastor would like to see the church print our own envelopes and give them to members quarterly. The word benevolence will be changed to mission support, to reflect the true meaning of giving.

The members of the Deacon and Communion Assistants will be: Dave Renninger, Dave Lang, Fran Dieter, and Jon Paul. They will make sure that all shut-ins will receive communion more often and will help Pastor John.

The church credit card was discussed. Jane Hecht will be in charge of the card and all ordering should go through the office. The card balance will be paid off every month. All ministries will be advised of this procedure.

The Transgender policy has been submitted and approved and entered to the church's records. Don Brooker made the motion and Sherry Petrosky seconded and the motion passed.

Lots of ideas were given about the landscaping around the church; the landscaping is out of control at this time. The Boy Scouts have been asked to help with the weeds and have not responded to the idea. Gary Reynolds will make some calls and get ideas from local landscapers.

#### **New Business:**

Jane Koch has talked with the Finance Committee and Bill Choler informed her that the parking sealing and stripping is a capital improvement and the Endowment should cover the parking lot. The paperwork will be submitted and given to the committee. A donor has given \$1500.00 and that amount will be used for part of the cost of the parking lot. The amount of \$4812.07 will be submitted to the Endowment Committee.

The cleaning of the hallways, Fellowship Hall and Narthex was discussed and it was decided that only the Fellowship Hall and the Narthex will be cleaned. Jane Koch made the motion to have the Fellowship Hall and the Narthex cleaned before Advent. Sandee Davis seconded and the motion was passed.

Background checks are required of everyone who works with children and youth. Those who have recently had these checks are required to bring copies of their background checks. Cost for those who need the check is \$15.00 per person. We will ask if they are willing to pay the fee; if not, we will take the cost from the appropriate designated account. We will give each person until September 28<sup>th</sup> to enter the information or give the papers to the church. After October 5<sup>th</sup>, anyone without a letter or information on file will not be permitted to work with the children or youth. Ray Rousseau made the motion to accept this policy and Sandee Davis seconded.

Prayer was given by Pastor John and the meeting adjourned.
