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Volusia County Fair & Youth Show GENERAL RULES

- 1. The management of the Volusia County Fair & Youth Show has the right to amend, add to, interpret and administer the rules and regulations, and to arbitrarily settle and determine all questions and differences in regard thereto, or otherwise arising out of, connected with, or incident to the Volusia County Fair, and their decision will be final. Any complaints must be in writing within thirty (30) days of the date of the complaint and delivered to the fair office of the Volusia County Fair Assn., Inc., at 3150 E. New York Ave. DeLand, FL 32724. Any evidence of fraud coming to the attention of the fair management will be prosecuted to the fullest extent of the law.
- 2. Exhibitors must live in Volusia County. Youth must meet age requirements as of September 1 of the current year, and be enrolled and in attendance in an elementary school, high school or home school in Volusia County at the time of entering items in the Volusia County Fair & Youth Show.
- 3. Social Security or Federal ID Number: If a Social Security Number or Federal ID Number is not provided, the Volusia County Fair reserves the right to not issue premium checks or money. Any exhibitor with a premium amount of \$100 or more will be required to provide a Social Security Number or Tax ID Number.
- 4. Premium book and official entry forms are available online at www.volusiacountyfair.com. A copy of the premium book can be obtained at the fair office (no e-mail, fax or mail).
- 5. All exhibits entered for competition shall be subject to the control of the superintendent of the department, with the approval of fair management, in which they are exhibited. Exhibitors are not permitted to remove, handle, rearrange, improve or disfigure the exhibit under any circumstances. No exhibit shall be removed in whole or part during the period of the fair, except by permission of the fair management. The fair reserves the right to not accept late or incomplete entry forms.
- 6. Removal of exhibits: Entry exhibits not picked up on the removal day will be held in the fair office for <u>seven (7) days only</u>. Exhibits will be discarded at the end of those seven (7) days. The fair can't store any exhibits and therefore, the fair association assumes no responsibility in case of loss or damage to exhibits not removed on the removal day.
- 7. The fair management reserves the right to refuse any entry deemed unsuitable as a Volusia County Fair & Youth Show exhibit.
- 8. Decision of the judges is final. Exhibitors, parents and general public are not allowed in the building(s) during the judging of exhibits.

Judging Method - AMERICAN SYSTEM:

- 9. Exhibits in this system, are compared against a standard of perfection, as well as against the other entries in the completion. All exhibits in a particular class are looked at and ranked with only one selected for first place, second place and third place. If there are no high-quality exhibits, at the judge's discretion, exhibits may be placed in the appropriate position, even if it is second or third place.
- 10. For rules and regulations governing each department, see rules in that department.
- 11. Responsibility: Upon signing the Volusia County Fair & Youth Show entry form, the exhibitor, parent and/or guardian agree that the Volusia County Fair Association, Inc., and the County of Volusia and/or it representatives are not to be held responsible for any exhibit entered for exhibition or for personal injury due to accidents, fire, theft or providential destruction. The fair association will exercise responsible vigilance in the care of exhibits for exhibition, but exhibits are entered at the owner's risk. Any exhibits entered the Volusia County Fair & Youth Show may be photographed and used by Volusia County Fair Association, Inc., for advertising. The Volusia County Fair Association, Inc., assumes no responsibility in case of loss or damage to exhibits from any cause and upon this condition only are exhibits accepted.

Premium award checks and money:

12. Premiums will be paid based on the cash and judging award reports, which must be verified and signed by the department superintendent. Premium checks and money are given on the removal day when exhibits are picked up. Premium checks awarded by the Volusia County Fair & Youth Show shall be cashed by the exhibitor within sixty (60) days from the last day of the fair. Premium monies awarded to an exhibitor, will be held at the fair office for sixty (60) days after the last day of the Volusia County Fair & Youth Show. If the exhibitors fails to timely collect money sixty (60) days or negotiate a check, after ninety (90) days, all money due to exhibitor shall belong to the Volusia County Fair Association, Inc., and the exhibitor shall be deemed to have made an unconditional and irrevocable gift of said monies to the Volusia County Fair Association. Premium checks and/or monies are not mail.

1939 WORLD'S FAIR DIORAMA'S

The dioramas from the 1939 World's Fair in New York were donated to the Volusia County Fair in 1982 by James Burkhalter. In 2007, the dioramas were redone to their original state by Mr. Burkhalter. The dioramas are on permanent display in "Mitchell/Bjorkman Antique Barn" by the model train display.

"MITCHELL/BJORKMAN ANTIQUE BARN"

As you enter "Mitchell/Bjorkman Antique Barn" you will step back to the days that are recalled as "The Good Old Days". Walking through "Mitchell/Bjorkman Antique Barn" it seems that you are in the days of an era long ago.

When walking through the Antique Barn, you will notice the preservation of energy, a fire-less cooker, a dog treadmill and many other interesting exhibits. There is horse drawn surreys, buggies, wagons and a chuck wagon, hand tools crudely made of wood and stone, and handmade wood carvings and machines that were used for everyday basic needs.

- 1. The contestant must be a resident of Volusia County and attend a school or home school in Volusia County.
- 2. Age limits: 14 19 years of age and in high school (single, never been married, not currently married; never been pregnant, and not now pregnant). Contestants must be 14 years of age as of September 1 of current year.
- 3. Contestants must attend rehearsal. NO EXCEPTIONS! Dress for rehearsal is casual.
- 4. Contestants must dress for judging competition in an evening or prom gown (full length, no cut outs).
- 5. Contestants will compete at the Volusia County Fair & Youth Show on opening night of the Volusia County Fair & Youth Show in the Tommy Lawrence Arena. (there is no preliminary judging)
- 6. The Miss Volusia County Fair queen will assist with the livestock shows and other events during the Volusia County Fair & Youth Show.
- 7. Past queen's will not be allowed to compete for a second time for the same title.
- 8. The semi-finalists will be named at the conclusion of evening gown competition by decision of the judges.
- 9. The semi-finalists will be interviewed on stage. The Miss Volusia County Fair queen, 1st runner up and 2nd runner up will be selected by decision of the judges. Decisions of the judges are final.
- 10.Each contestant will be judged on: Personality, poise and public speaking.
- 11. The Volusia County Fair Association, Inc., reserves the right to disqualify a contestant, and may prevent a contestant from participating in future Miss Volusia County Fair pageants, for conduct unbecoming to a contestant.
- 12.Each contestant will receive their speech topic on the day of rehearsal.
- 13. Consent of parent or guardian: Applicants under 18 years of age must have the signed permission of a parent or legal guardian to participate in the pageant. The signature of a parent or legal guardian on the entry form will be considered as their consent.
- 14. The superintendent shall have the final say on any deviation or conflict regarding rules.

- 15. The decision of judges is final.
- 16. Award money will be available for pick up at the fair office seven (7) days from the day of the pageant. Award money awarded to a recipient and not collected, will be held at the fair office for sixty (60) days after the last day of the Volusia County Fair & Youth Show. If the recipient fails to timely negotiate said check or collect money, after sixty (60) days, from the last day of the fair, all award money due to recipient shall belong to the Volusia County Fair Association, Inc., and the recipients shall be deemed to have made an unconditional and irrevocable gift of said money to the Volusia County Fair Association, Inc. Award money is not mailed.

Rules:

- 1. Contestant(s) must be a resident of Volusia County and be in attendance in a school or home school in Volusia County. Contestants will be given one (1) contestant and two (2) parent family performances passes. (performances with more than one (1) family, each contestant will be allowed one (1) pass and only two (2) parent passes)
- 2. Contestants must pre-register— no exceptions. Entry forms are to be handed in at the fair office (no e-mail, fax or mail) or to the superintendent no later than the deadline date.
- 3. Amateur acts only. No contestant will be considered if they have ever received a fee for performing.
- 4. Contestants will compete against their age division. Group acts will compete in age division of the oldest member. Contestants may compete in only one (1) age division.
- 5. Previous senior division 1st place winners are not eligible to compete in the talent contest. Junior division 1st place winners may compete in the senior division when age requirements are met.
- 6. Sound equipment: Sound equipment, microphones, CD player will be sponsored and operated by fair personnel.

- 7. Musical instruments: The fair does not provide musical instruments. Check with superintendent on availability of a keyboard.
- 8. Props must be sponsored by the contestant. Props are to be kept to a minimum and will be the responsibility of the contestant for access to and from the stage for show.
- 9. Acts may not exceed 4 (four) minutes. Acts will be timed. Points will be deducted for overtime.
- 10.Judging will be based on:
 - A. Talent (ability, difficulty and skill)
 - B. Presentation (poise, confidence and audience appeal)
 - C. Costume-Staging (age appropriate, clever and creative)
- 11. The fair reserves the right to disallow any act that may be deemed unsuitable for the Volusia County Fair.
- 12. The Volusia County Fair has the right to disqualify a contestant and may prevent a contestant from participating in future amateur talent show, for conduct unbecoming to a contestant.
- 13.Each contestant will be given a time their performance will be on show day. Performances times could vary and contestants must be flexible with changes that may occur.
- 14. The superintendent shall have final say on any deviation or conflict regarding rules. The decision of judges is final.

The Volusia County Fair Technology Education Program is an activity designed to encourage the understanding of technology and development of craftsmanship among secondary students enrolled in engineering and technology education. Project eligibility:

Any entry made in school under the supervision of a technology education teacher and which qualifies according to the rules and regulations may be entered. At least 70% of the project must be fabricated in the school laboratory. Entries in divisions 2000 and 2001 must be individual entries. Team/class projects may be presented for display only.

Numbers of entries:

All divisions may be entered but only one (1) entry per class.
