Camp 7 Scholarship Guidelines

Please review the Camp 7 Scholarship Application Checklist and provide all required documentation to determine eligibility.

Applicants must submit a letter describing the need for financial assistance for Camp 7 (preferably from a 3rd party). In addition, the family must meet at least one of the following criteria and meet the income guideline of 150% of the Federal Poverty Level Guideline (FPLG):

- Child(ren) homeless or involved in foster care.
- Child(ren) of full-time working parents (minimum of 32 hours per week, provide at least three most recent paystubs from parent and/or guardian responsible for camp payment).
- Child(ren) of a parent/parents with special needs receiving social security benefits (must provide documentation of benefits).
- Child(ren) of part-time working parents (working 25-31 hours per week, provide at least three most recent paystubs from parent and/or guardian responsible for camp payment).
- Child(ren) who are in legal custody of their grandparents or other family members (must provide custody documents).
- Child(ren) whose family receives TANF and/or SNAP benefits (must provide DHS documentation).

****Even if your family does not meet one of the eligibility categories above, we urge families to apply with a letter explaining the family's circumstances.**

****Applications are processed on a first come, first serve basis. All documentation must be provided to be considered.**

****Not every family will receive the full amount that is requested. All families will be required to at least pay the registration fee \$30/child. If you have a balance due from a previous year's program, that must balance must be paid in full before any future enrollment or scholarship applications will be considered.**
