Our congregation practices open communion, welcoming all Christians to the communion table Ommunion wherever they are in their faith journey or membership. Children are also welcome to receive the bread or a blessing, according to the wishes of their parents. At the same time, we continue to have a first communion training for elementary age children. This gives young children a chance to meet in a small group together with pastors and parents, asking questions and learning communion cus-

toms. Following the one session training, families and children will be recognized and commune together on Sunday March 27. First communion training remains a faith milestone. Parents can sign up for training with Pastor Chris.

Twelve campers have signed up for summer camp with Cross Trails Ministry.

Parents have paid the \$150 registration fee. Fundraisers and donations will help cover the remaining \$485 per person fee.

Coming up first is our traditional Little Caesar's Pizza Kit sale. Each item sold earns \$6 for our camper fund. We need to sell 100 items to avoid shipping fees. Various pepperoni or cheese pizzas, two kind of bread and a few kinds of cookie dough are available. Campers and others will be taking orders from February 28 through March 20; delivery is the week of April 4. Enjoy some great food while helping our campers have a great week of faith formation at Camp Chrysalis.


