**Mark Eichner** has served as Music Director and Conductor since 2002. A music educator for 41 years, he was the Wind Ensemble and Community Band Conductor, trumpet instructor, and a teacher of coursework in Music Education at UW-Parkside from 1982-2014. He

served as Department Chair from 1998-2007. As a trumpeter, he has performed in the Milwaukee Symphony Orchestra, the Wisconsin Philharmonic, the Chicagoland Pops Orchestra, the Brass Band of Battle Creek, the Florentine Opera, the Woodstock Mozart Festival, and the Skylight Opera Theater. As the founder of BrassWorks, he led brass quintet performances including a nationally broadcast concert at the Chicago Cultural Center, university and civic festival concerts and assisted the Canadian Brass in their Wisconsin tour performances.

**Don Rosen** is a broadcast veteran of over 50 years. Currently, he is heard mornings 6-9am on WRJN: 1400 AM, 99.9 FM and 98.1 FM. Don and his wife Terry have always been fans of the Racine Concert Band Sunday night concerts at the zoo.
