WHERE WAS THE BAND?

In one of the craziest finishes in college football history, Miami (FL) beat Duke 30-27 on an 8-lateral kickoff return after Duke had seemly won the game with 6 seconds left on the clock moments earlier. The play actually lasted for a whopping 46 seconds of real time and when officials reviewed the play they determined that a Miami player's knee was not down prior to pitching it backward and they determined that what had been called a block in the back on the field was from the side, and therefore legal, so the play stood and the Hurricanes were victorious. Several of those on-field ACC officials, as well as the replay official, were suspended on November 1st for not officiating the game properly. They also missed a helmetless Miami player that ran onto the field prior to the conclusion of the play. Regardless of how it was officiated, it's an all-time finish that will not be forgotten anytime soon. The only thing missing from this play was the band coming onto the field and a trombone player being thumped as the player crossed the goal line. The fact that this happened on Halloween night just seem appropriate. When Michigan State stunned Michigan 2 weeks ago and Georgia Tech's "block six" shocked FSU last week we thought it can't get any crazier than those 2 finishes and then this happened. Why shouldn't we be surprised when something like this happens?

In other games this past weekend, Michigan stopped Minnesota right at the goal line to stop the Gophers' upset bid to keep Michigan in the hunt for the Big Ten's East Division title. Notre Dame had to score late in the 4th quarter to defeat Temple 24-20. This Temple team played a great game but Notre Dame showed that even on an off night they can still find a way to win. Clemson continued to look great on offense, evident of the 56 points they scored vs NC State but they need to get their defense to play better. Giving up 41 points to NC State is a little concerning. Stanford was sluggish for most of their game at Washington State but they survived for a 30-28 win when WSU kicker Erik Powell (who had already kicked 5 FG's in the game) missed from 43 yards out as the clock hit :00. Ole Miss still controls their destiny after beating Auburn 27-19. If the Rebels win out, they'll represent the SEC Western Division in Atlanta.

Florida State (7-1) goes to Death Valley to take on undefeated Clemson (8-0) in the biggest ACC regular season game of the year. We're believers in the Dabo Swinney and his Tigers. Duke (6-2) goes to Chapel Hill to take on North Carolina (7-1). The Blue Devils have to put the loss to Miami behind them while the Tar Heels try to prove that they're a team to be taken seriously. Notre Dame (7-1) goes to Heinz Field to take on Pittsburgh (6-2). The Irish almost lost to Temple last week and the Panthers will be just as good as the Owls so Notre Dame better if they're to come away with another road win. Michigan State (8-0) at Nebraska (3-6). The Huskers are by far the best 6 loss team in American. MSU better not overlook Nebraska or they'll get beat. Penn State (7-2) travels to Chicagoland to take on Northwestern (6-2). The undefeated LSU Tigers (7-0) invade Tuscaloosa to take on Alabama (7-1) in a key SEC game that will be televised nationally on CBS at 8:00 PM EST.

Both of these teams were off last week so each has had 2 weeks to prepare. LSU quarterback, Brandon Harris has played very good recently and for LSU to be successful, he has to be a threat passing the ball because everyone knows that RB Leonard Fournette will be the most talented player on the field for the Tigers. Defensively, LSU has been average at best. They allow too many yards and points. The Tigers are giving up an average of about 22½ points per-game so far this season. On the other side of the field, Alabama has looked very good at times (vs Georgia & Texas A&M) and then they have looked vulnerable at times as well like they did vs Ole Miss and Tennessee. QB Jacob Coker needs to play smart and complete passes but if Derrick Henry can have success running the ball, it's going to be hard to beat Alabama.

Alabama leads the all-time series vs LSU 49-25-5. In Tuscaloosa, Alabama leads 10-9 and when they used to play in Birmingham, Alabama was 8-5-1 vs LSU. Alabama has won the last 4 games in this series including last season's 20-17 overtime victory in Baton Rouge. It helps to be the home team but even if the game was in Baton Rouge, we still believe that Alabama would find a way to win. We're going with the Crimson

#1 RANKED TEAMS IN THE WEEKLY AP POLL (1970-2015)

Below are the dates and schools of every #1 team in the weekly AP poll since 1970. Since 1970 there have been 2 occasions when there was a tie for the #1 ranking. Those weeks are October 20th, 1992 and August 26, 2002. The AP poll has been released 736 times from 1970 to November 1, 2015. That total includes the 46 preseason #1 teams from 1970-2015. Ohio State has been ranked #1 more than any other school since 1970 (77 times). You will notice that there was no poll released on September 16th, 2001. That was due to the fact that there were no major college football games played that previous week as a result of the terrorist attacks on New York City and Washington DC on September 11th, 2001.



COLLEGE FOOTBALL HIDDEN GEMS: OKLAHOMA STATE'S BOONE PICKENS STADIUM

Originally known as Lewis Field, Boone Pickens Stadium, located on the campus of Oklahoma State is one of the more intimate stadiums in college football.

Football was first played on this site in 1913 but the actual structure wasn't built until 1920 when the school

constructed permanent stands seating 8,000. In 1947 13,000 seats were added along with a new press box.

Over the years, various expansions pushed the capacity to around 50,000 but the stadium was nothing to get too excited about. Prior to the 1972 season, the cinder

running track was removed and the playing surface was lowered 12 feet allowing seats to be added towards the field. This expansion created the smallest space between the sidelines and the front row of seats in all of college football. The one flaw with this is the threat of a player running full speed towards the sideline and hitting the wall especially the closer you get to the endzones.

When oil millionaire T. Boone Pickens got involved everything changed for this structure. Pickens donated millions of dollars for upgrades to several Oklahoma State athletic facilities, including Gallagher-Iba Arena. First and foremost, however, his money went towards the massive renovation of Lewis Field to help OSU keep up with other schools in the Big 12 but more importantly, to keep up with Oklahoma over in Norman. The Sooners had always been the big brother in the state and, frankly, Oklahoma State was tired of feeling like a second class citizen in their own state. When the renovation was completed, the transformation was as remarkable as any stadium renovation in the country. The structure is aesthetically pleasing to the eye, with the new brick exterior and the clean lines. The school was so overjoyed with Boone Pickens' generous gifts, that they renamed the facility in his honor.

The stadium now seats 60,218 and has all of the bells and whistles of a newly constructed stadium. Not surprisingly, the fortune of the Oklahoma St program has coincided with this renovation. It appears that as long as OSU keeps up in the arms race with the likes of Oklahoma and Texas, they'll stay in the hunt in the Big 12.
