Theresa M. Eynon, 80 of Sebawaing, passed away Sunday evening, Dec. 24, at her home following an extended illness.

She was born Feb. 5, 1915 in Caro, the daughter of the late Ole and Margaret (Beardsly) Montague. She was united in marriage to George McAlpine in 1933. He preceded her in death. She then married Ernest Eynon on May 18, 1945 in Flint. He preceded her Dec. 11, 1972.
