Some of them have a sharp edge, below the mooring loop, that is shaving the face of the cube off little by little. Please check the way you are tying your boat and adjust your rope so as to keep the boat from hitting the front of the slip. Thanks

### DID YOU KNOW??

**Ontario's Family Fishing Week** is June 30<sup>th</sup> to July 8<sup>th</sup> and during this time you are able to fish *without a fishing license!!*

There are a few rules that do apply:

- follow conservation license catch limits
- obey size limits and sanctuaries
- follow the fishing regulations

**(available in the Store, we are in Zone 18)**

It is the responsibility of the angler to know the regulations for the area that they are fishing in. Happy Fishing!!

### Summer is Here!

Now that Summer is here, the days will be getting hot! Make sure that you do not use water in excess, and refrain from washing vehicles or trailers on the weekends when water is in demand. The number of people in the park directly effects the water pressure, so please use it wisely and effectively.

### Fish Cleaning Station

We would like to encourage all guests of Cedar Cove Resort to use the **Fish Cleaning Station**. When using the fish cleaning station, please use the newspaper and bags provided, and place the entrails in the freezer.

Our hope is that our guests will put the entrails in the freezer rather than the dumpsters.

We will gladly be removing the frozen entrails on a regular basis.

### Renewals 2019!!

You are able to renew at any time during our hours of operation while Carol or Kayla are in the office! Getting your renewal done early is great; you may be eligible for an early payment discount on your seasonal rate AND you can enjoy your whole summer without having to worry about renewing before you leave in the fall!

There are **3** ways to renew!

1- You may choose to pay in full by cheque, debit or credit (credit transaction incur a 4% charge on renewal fees).

From June 29 to July 31 you could receive a discount of 3.5%-3.9% .

2- You may wish to pay with 3 equal cheques! The first cheque is dated for the date that you renew, the second for January 1<sup>st</sup>, and the third for April 30<sup>th</sup>.

3- You may also choose to pay by pre-authorized debit, where we split your total site fees and other renewal charges into 12 equal payments that comes out on the 20<sup>th</sup> of each month from October 2018 to September 2019.

**You can choose any of these options for your renewal! If you have any questions, please don't hesitate to ask us in Reception!**

The deadline to renew is **September 15**, but please try not to leave your renewal until September.

Renewals done after September 15<sup>th</sup> 2018 will incur a \$50 late registration fee.

This year when you renew, we will go through a new/updated License of Occupation.

Colouring pages must be brought back to the **Store** by **10AM Sunday Morning** to be entered into the contest.

Winners are posted on Sundays 11am on the Store window!

### KEY FOBS

**Your key fob is for you only, please do not use it to let in your friends, family members, other seasonal guests, or service workers.**

Please be reminded that there is a 20 minute time limit on key fobs. Registered visitors must check in at Reception and give a \$5 deposit for a key fob to gain entrance to the park. This \$5 deposit will be returned to the visitor when the key fob is returned to Reception. Seasonal Guests are not permitted to pay this \$5 deposit, as it is the only way that we can keep track of who is in the park. The only way that the visitor would not receive this deposit back, is if they left after Reception closes (8pm Sunday-Thursday, 9pm Friday/Saturday), or if they simply do not return the key fob.

### VISITORS AND SERVICE WORKERS

Visitors and service workers must be registered for any time of year, any day of the week.

We do not allow anyone into the park who is not registered with us in Reception (no surprise visitors).

To register a guest or service worker, you may call 613-623-3133 and leave a message, come into Reception in person, or email [vacation@cedarcove.ca](mailto:vacation@cedarcove.ca).

There are charges associated with having visitors to your site. We start charging when the pool opens, and we stop charging when the pool closes in September. No fee for service worker come to your site.

## Campfire Rules

There is no fire ban in effect at this time, but that doesn't mean that a forest fire can't happen!  
- If it's too windy, please don't have a fire! Wind gusts can be unpredictable and can blow hot embers to nearby dry areas.  
- Have a bucket of water by your fire pit to extinguish fire. Completely extinguish a fire by pouring the water on the fire until the "hissing" stops.  
If you don't have a bucket of water to extinguish your fire, use a shovel to add and stir around dirt or sand. Continue to do this until all embers are buried and materials are cool to touch.  
"If it's too hot to touch, it's too hot to leave".  
- Never leave your fire unattended, or leave children or pets unattended with a fire.  
- Keep your fire at a **manageable size**.  
- Never burn household garbage in your firepit.

## OPPORTUNITY FOR TWEENS/TEENS!!

If your tween/teen is interested in babysitting for Seasonal Guests, sign up in Reception! Perspective parents will then have the opportunity to check the list and arrange a meeting! The babysitter can then meet the child, discuss times/dates, and forms of payment! We think that this is another great way for the younger guests in the park to be a part of the Cedar Cove Community!

## Bocce Ball Tournament

As per last year, every long weekend seasonal guests host the Long Weekend Bocce Ball Tournament. When there is **no lifeguard** on duty, we can only allow 10 people in the pool/on deck for safety reasons.

Children 12 years old or younger **must** have an adult guardian with them in the pool area.

**No drinks, food, or pets are allowed in the pool area.** Bottled water only.

## MERMAID TAILS

Mermaid tails will unfortunately no longer be allowed in the pool do to safety concerns.

Mermaid tails are to be used at the beach only at the risk of the user.

## Site cleanup!

We have taken the liberty to cut a lot of peoples grass and noticed too many trailers and boats still on the sites. It's July 1<sup>st</sup>, time to get your sites in order! We would very much appreciate it if you could make sure that any boat or trailer that may still be on your site, goes to the proper place to be stored for the season. We thank you all for your co-operation!

## Just a few reminders...

**These reminders are important for all guests of Cedar Cove Resort.**

**Seasonal Guests (old and new!) and all of our temporary campers!**

-The docks are in and they're BEAUTIFUL! Please be reminded that you can only fish off of the **X and Y** docks! If you are unsure of your dock slip number, please contact us at **Reception**.

- Use only **1-ply toilet paper** during your stay at Cedar Cove Resort! We have rolls for sale in the Store. You can also purchase 1-ply from Rona (24 rolls for under \$20).

- **Quiet hours** are 11pm to 9am every night with the exception of Saturdays; 12midnight – 10am Sundays. *"Youth's under the age of 19 and other persons who are not the Principal Occupants of a site are to be under the direct supervision of the Principal Occupants during "Quiet Hours""* – Long Term Brochure.

- Keep your septic system happy ☺ be sure to pour SEPTO-CLEAN down your toilet! For sale in the **Store!**

- Be sure to watch your speed in the park! The speed limit is **15km/hr!!** This time of year children will be playing outside, biking and running around, and we need to be watchful!

- *"By law, every cyclist under age 18 must wear an approved helmet. **Riders under 16 years old: a parent or guardian must make sure their child wears a helmet.**"* Service Ontario Publications.

- **Open Alcohol:** Cedar Cove Resort is not a licensed facility, so open alcohol is not permitted off of your site at any time, so please refrain from walking around the park with alcohol (in the bottle or in the can).

- **Drinking and Driving:** Cedar Cove Resort does not tolerate drinking and driving in any motorized vehicle (this includes golf carts and boats). For the safety of the children, pets, and other adults in the park, please **never** drink and drive. We do not want to have any accidents.

The police patrolled the water quite often last year, and we hope that they will be out again this year, ensuring the safety of people on the water as well!

- For safety reasons, please wear shoes or sandals if you are leaving your site.

Shoes and shirts should be worn to enter the Store, Lodge, and The Lakeside Grill.

- **No fireworks, firecrackers, or floating lanterns are permitted on Cedar Cove Resort property at any time.**
