The Legion will be on the Left in 1.5 miles.

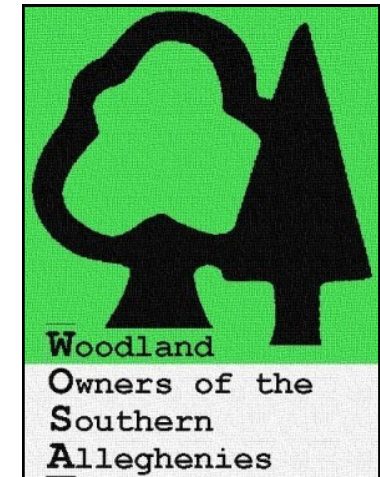
