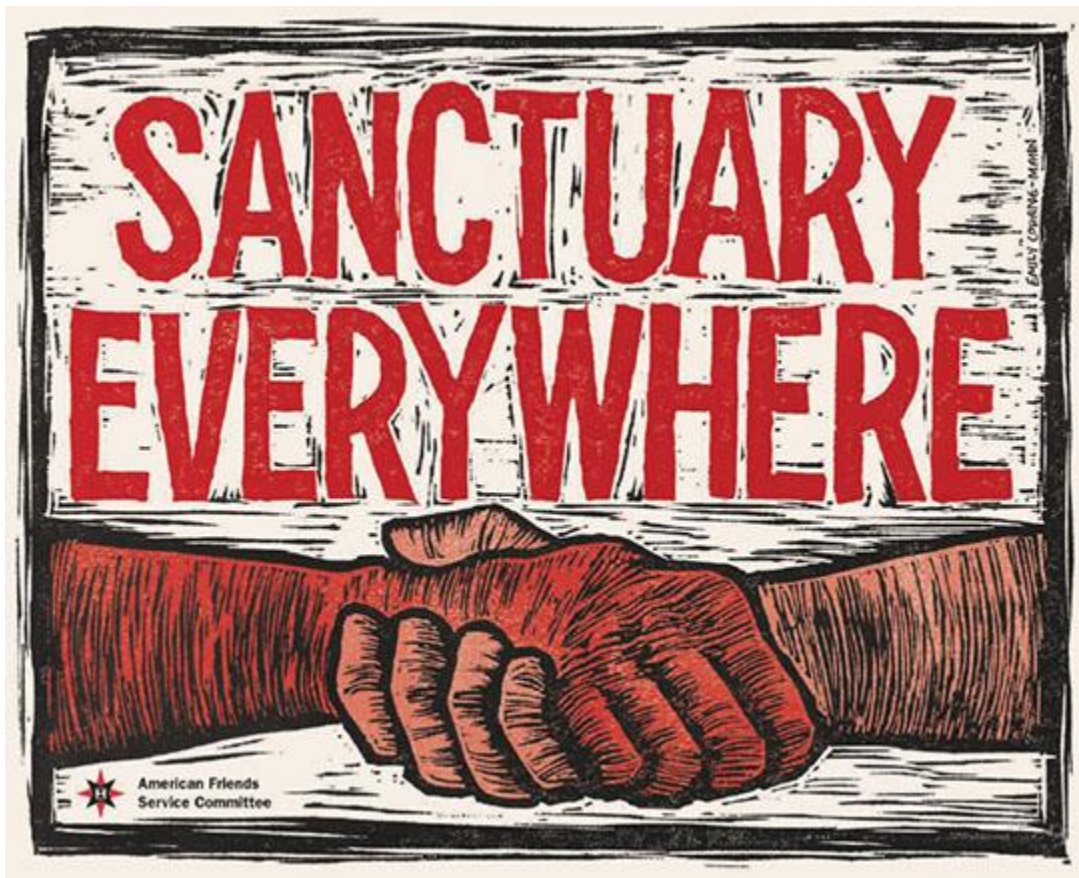

Yesterday, the Congressional Budget Office (CBO) released their analysis of the Senate's Better Health Care Act. The CBO analysis confirmed a lot of what we already knew about the bill: it is going to leave millions more uninsured and decrease Medicaid funding by billions of dollars. While Senate Republicans just announced that they will be delaying the vote until after the July recess, it is important that we continue to advocate for the protection of healthcare for all Americans.

What We Know

- According to the CBO, an additional 22 million people would lose health care coverage over the next decade.
- By 2026, 15 million fewer people would be enrolled in Medicaid than projected under the ACA. Currently, over 74 million low-income and disabled individuals are Medicaid beneficiaries.
- According to the **Center for American Progress**, over 1 million New Yorkers would lose coverage either through Medicaid or the individual market by 2026.
- Over the next decade, federal spending on Medicaid would drop by 26 percent or \$772 billion.

Action Needed

With the Senate Republican leaders delaying the vote on this bill until after the recess, we know that the pressure from advocates across the country is working. We now have the opportunity to keep the pressure on! Here are some things we can do:

Project Kidz Talk©

What is Project Kidz Talk©?

The purpose of Project Kidz Talk© is to increase social support, reduce isolation and help family members (primary and secondary victims) cope with the effects of sexual abuse.

Who can participate?

Sexual abuse impacts the whole family. All non-offending family members may attend Project Kidz Talk©. This means the caregivers of the child victim are welcome to attend the program as well as any siblings of the child victim. For a family member to participate they must be aware, in an age appropriate manner, of the abuse which occurred.

How does it work?

Project Kidz Talk© begins at 6pm with dinner provided. This is an opportunity for families to connect with their children. At 6:45pm dinner ends and everyone separates to attend their support group.

What are the different groups?

Support groups provide an opportunity for individuals to connect with others who have experiences in common. Groups help bring individuals together with those who may be able to help them most, others who truly know the challenges you are facing.



Caregiver Support Group:

The caregiver support group provides an opportunity for those raising the child to share with other caregivers about topics such as parenting, communicating as a family and coping with the abuse.

Child Support Groups:

Support groups for children are divided by age. Groups may consist of both primary and secondary victims, such as siblings. The group provides an opportunity for children to see they are not alone and heal together.

What are the benefits of Project Kidz Talk©?

Project Kidz Talk© helps families heal together by improving coping skills., building the family's support network, lessen isolation and sense of shame, and helping families connect as a unit.

¿Qué es Project Kidz Talk ©?

El propósito de Project Kidz Talk © es aumentar el apoyo social, reducir el aislamiento y ayudar a los miembros de la familia (las víctimas primarias y secundarias) a manejar los efectos del abuso sexual.

¿Quién puede participar?

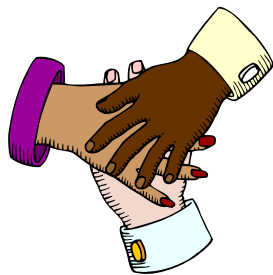
El abuso sexual afecta a toda la familia. Todos los miembros de la familia que no son infractor pueden asistir en Project Kidz Talk ©. Esto significa que los cuidadores las víctimas están invitados a asistir al programa, así como cualquier hermanos de la víctima. Para que un miembro de la familia pueda participar deben tener en cuenta, de una manera apropiada para su edad, del abuso que ocurrió.

¿Cómo funciona?

Project Kidz Talk © comienza a las 6 pm con una cena. Esta es una oportunidad para las familias conectar con sus hijos. A las 6:45 pm termina la cena y todos los participantes se separan para asistir a su grupo de apoyo.

¿Cuáles son los diferentes grupos?

Los grupos de apoyo ofrecen una oportunidad para que las personas se conecten con otros que



que está enfrentando.

Grupos de apoyo para padres:

El grupo de apoyo para padres proporciona una oportunidad para aquellos que están criando al niño a compartir con otros padres sobre temas como crianza de los hijos, la comunicación en familia y manejar los efectos del abuso.

Grupos de apoyo para niños:

Los grupos de apoyo para los niños son divididos por edad. Los grupos pueden consistir de víctimas primarias y secundarias, tales como hermanos. El grupo proporciona una oportunidad para que los

niños vean que no están solos y puedan sanar juntos.

¿Cuáles son los beneficios del Project Kidz Talk ©?

Project Kidz Talk © ayuda a las familias sanar juntos en mejorando las habilidades de afrontamiento. La construcción de la red de apoyo a la familia, disminuir el aislamiento y la sensación de vergüenza, y ayudar a las familias a conectarse .
