The Resurrection of the Lord
John 20:1-9

“They have taken the Lord from the tomb, and we don’t know where they have put him”

When Mary of Magdala entered the tomb where the body of Jesus had been hastily lain she was surprised to see that his body was no longer in the tomb. She logically concluded that his body had been taken. Jesus had tried to prepare his disciples and friends that he would be killed and then rise from the dead, but it was a concept they were slow to comprehend. Mary of Magdala runs to tell the disciples, who are behind locked. In light of all that had happened over the past three days they had good reason to be frightened. Peter and John rush to the tomb and find it empty. They recall what Jesus had foretold. Still, they did not fully understand. They would eventually encounter the resurrected Jesus several times and come to believe. The strength of their faith is demonstrated by the risk they took, the trials they endured and the deaths they faced for proclaiming the Good News of the Life, Death and Resurrection of Jesus. Today we celebrate his Resurrection. How strong is our faith? How do we demonstrate our faith?
