



PCS (Permanent Change of Station) Savings: \$6,966,620 Average separation/retirement (individual) Air Force PCS

Cost - \$8.548

910 Exiting Military acknowledged staying in the local area With data input estimated that 20% (182) will use PCS to relocate in local area

728 (not using PCS) x \$8,548 = **\$6,222,944**

437 Exiting Military are Unsure of staying in the area – after meeting with CRA Group to learn local career opportunities, it is estimated 20% (87) will remain in the local area \$743,676

(UCX) Unemployment Compensation for Ex-Service Members Savings: \$536,250

Florida maximum weekly UCX payment is \$275.00 for up to 12 weeks; \$3,300 per individual 488 eligible Exiting Military Eligible for UCX Benefits Staying

(Deducting the Military retiring that are not eligible for UCX)

With CRA Group assistance to secure job placement within 7 weeks

488 Eligible @ 80% placement within 7 weeks = 390 individuals@ 7 weeks of payment of UCX

@\$275/week = **\$536,250** (**\$1375** per person)


