THE MIRACLE BIRTH OF THE MESSIAH – Part II By Wade Anderson

In Matthew 1:1-16, we find the lineage of Joseph, Jesus' earthly father. As scripture reveals it was only through marriage that Joseph was Jesus' father. When we read these records of lineage keep in mind that Matthew, a Jew himself, was writing to the Jesus so he felt it important to present Jesus not only as the Messiah but as, "... the Son of David, the Son of Abraham ..." (Matthew 1:1). However in the Book of Luke, we find Jesus' lineage being traced through Mary, His mother. Luke, a Greek and a physician, was writing to the Gentile audience and records Mary's lineage from a much different aspect than Matthew's account. Luke travels all the way back through time to Adam, the son of God. (Luke 3:23-38)

Luke gives us the most detailed accounts of Jesus' birth. Luke records that many have come before him as "... eyewitnesses, and ministers of the word ..." (Luke 1:2) and goes on to record in Luke 1:3, "With this in mind, since I myself have carefully investigated everything from the beginning, I too decide to write an orderly account ..." Tradition reveals that Luke talked and inquired of Mary of these personal accounts of her Son's birth so this would be Mary's story and not some fictional invention.

We find both Joseph and Mary as being in the royal lineage of David. However, in Joseph's family tree we see a descendent by the name of Jeconiah, also called Coniah. As I mentioned last month, this is where we will begin to understand why it is recorded in *Genesis 3:15* as "her Seed" instead of the seed of Adam, or man. The answer lies in reading Jeremiah 22:30, "Thus says the Lord: 'Write this man down as childless, A man who shall not prosper in his days; For none of his descendents shall prosper, Sitting on the throne of David, And ruling anymore in Judah."" Being born of David's lineage there would be a new king, but as this scripture reveals, there would be no cursed blood in this King. This is why Jesus was to be born of a virgin "her seed" and of the Holy Spirit, not man's seed.

The birth of Jesus was not one of natural events but of supernatural events so we must look at Mary, the mother of Jesus. There is nothing in scripture that tells us of Mary being anyone of some grandiose wealthy family but she is in the royal lineage of David. Hopefully you've followed along in your Bibles, and already read of this account in *Luke3:23-38*. At the earliest recording of Mary, she is found to be a humble young girl, barely out of her teens, and crossing the threshold of womanhood while living in the village of Nazareth. Like every other young woman her age living in that area, she was more than likely accustomed to her everyday domestic activities and duties and probably didn't perceive much outside of her immediate surroundings. We know from history that it was custom in the East for the young women to be pledged by their family to be married at an early age.

We first find Mary in scripture in the midst of being spoken to by the angel Gabriel. His opening statement to her was, "Rejoice, highly favored one, the Lord is with you; blessed are you among women!" (Luke 1:28) Remember that Mary was of a humble upbringing and couldn't even imagine what this announcement would mean to her. Possibly trembling, confused and overwhelmed Mary stood in dismay of what Gabriel went on to proclaim. "... Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favor with God. And behold, you will conceive in your womb and bring forth a Son, and shall call His name Jesus." (Luke 1:31) We can only imagine what Mary was about to experience both in the natural from man, and through the supernatural hand of God. These events would be more than overwhelming to say the least. Mary's first response to Gabriel's message from God was, "How could this be, since I do not know a man?" (Luke 1:34) This seems to be very appropriate ground to stand on for anyone thinking of natural child birth. The angel went on to further assure her in Luke 1:35 that this was by no means a natural but supernatural event that was about to take place, "The Holy Spirit will come upon you, and the power of the Highest will overshadow you; therefore, also, that Holy One who is to be born will be called the Son of God." Mary's second response to Gabriel brought forth with it nothing of doubt or unbelief but one filled with humbled faith and obedience as she replied, "Behold the maidservant of the Lord! Let it be done to me according to your word." (Luke 1:38) All in all, I'm sure you all would agree that Mary handled her encounter with Gabriel and her coming pregnancy, quite well.

Although Mary's hand in marriage had been promised to Joseph, she probably figured this wasn't the right time to confide in him, or anyone else there in Nazareth. I'm sure you all can see why it might not have seemed the appropriate time to approach Joseph with this new news. Even though Mary believed and received the message Gabriel had brought to her, she might have felt very isolated from everyone, especially Joseph. Quite possibly, it was while Mary was hurriedly leaving Nazareth to the hill country of Judea, while on her journey to sort these things out, that she may have remembered the message Gabriel revealed to her concerning her cousin Elizabeth, "Elizabeth your relative has also conceived a son in her old age ..." (Luke 1:36)

Would Elizabeth be the one Mary would first confide in? Would she receive the wisdom and counsel she would need for what lay ahead of her? As Mary entered the home of Zachariah and Elizabeth, Luke 1:41 records that, "... the babe leaped in her womb; and Elizabeth was filled with the Holy Spirit." As Elizabeth continued to speak, Mary heard these reassuring words of prophesy as the Holy Spirit had revealed them to her, "Blessed are you among women, and

blessed is the fruit of your womb! But why is this granted to me, that the mother of my Lord should come to me?... Blessed is she who believed, for there will be a fulfillment of those things which were told her from the Lord." (Luke 1:42-45) Reading through these above scriptures, we see that both Mary and Elizabeth were chosen to fulfill Bible prophesy. It's revealed further on in the Scriptures that Elizabeth's child, the one that leaped for joy in Elizabeth belly at the very presence of Mary entering the room, would be none other than the forerunner for Jesus, known as John the Baptist.

Although it's obvious to see that Mary had received the assurance she was in search of, how would she ever be able to comfort Joseph's concern and disbelief of her being with child? For this information, we will be going now to the accounts in the **Book of Matthew** as Matthew spoke more from Joseph's side of this story. Now it's on to Joseph.

Like any other young girl (sadly, maybe not as much in our present day) who finds herself pregnant and unmarried, Mary more than likely thought 'there's a lot of explaining to do'. The Bible doesn't tell us whether Mary had found a way to tell Joseph or not. By now it's quite possible that the time frame of pregnancy itself was revealing the Child. Either way, Matthew only tells us that, "... she was found with child of the Holy Spirit." (Matthew 1:18b) Matthew also tells us of Joseph, "... being a just man ..." (Matthew 1:19) In the Strong's Concordance, 'just' in this verse, is the Greek word dikaios(#1342) and means, equitable in character or act, by applying innocent, upright, blameless, and righteous. This one word alone reveals the man that Joseph truly was. Joseph was a very prominent, skillful carpenter and tradesman there in Nazareth. Among the many questions running through his mind, we might easily imagine him thinking, "How will I ever be able to look the people of Nazareth in the eye again?" It's not hard to imagine the feelings of betrayal and disgrace that Joseph thought he was about to experience.

Knowing Joseph to be a 'just' man his thoughts are revealed to us in the remainder of **Matthew 1:19**, "... being a just man, and not wanting to make her a public example, was minded to put her away secretly." Even though Joseph had uneasiness in his mind, his character is revealed by the word "secretly". I know there have been all these years and different cultures that have lapsed since these accounts of Joseph, but I ask you, "In the same situation, would our character reveal 'secretly' or 'spectacle'?"

In the midst of these thoughts, an angel of the Lord appeared to Joseph in a dream saying, "Joseph, son of David, do not be afraid to take to you Mary your wife, for that which is conceived in her is of the Holy Spirit. And she will bring forth a Son, and you shall call His name Jesus, for He will save His people from their sins." (Matthew 1:20-21) Coming away from this dream Joseph's confusion was now filled with pure joy. With eagerness and no more hesitation, Joseph did as he was commanded and took Mary for his wife. Joseph did not have her to himself until after she had given birth to Jesus. (Matthew 1:25) Although Mary, as a young girl having attended the synagogues, and hearing the Scriptures being taught on the Sabbath, never would have thought the prophesy fulfillment in Isaiah 7:14 would be accomplished in and through her.

In Rome in the days just prior to Jesus' birth, as we've mentioned last month, Augustus Caesar sat and ruled from the throne of an empire that was greater than any the world had ever known. As his empire grew so did his need for a solution to finance his kingdom. Along with kingdom costs he also had to accommodate the cost of his administration and his great army. As they searched for an answer to his predicament it was soon realized that most of the Provinces were paying tribute to Caesar, but Palestine was not. Having decided that each country must share in its part of the burden he issued a decree for a census to be taken of the entire Roman world. This meant that everyone would have to return to their hometown to register for the census. Even though all of the rugged trails were being transformed into easier traveling roadways, the people still moved about on foot, and in some cases on animals.

Even though Mary was expecting this new Child, Joseph knew that it was necessary to report for the census. Joseph took Mary and leaving Nazareth headed out on the journey towards Bethlehem, the city of David. No sooner than they arrived in Bethlehem, and Mary found herself in the midst of birth pains and about to give birth. As they searched they soon found the inns were full. With nowhere else to turn they resolved to a spot in a nearby stable. Finding refuge there, Mary soon gave birth to Jesus, her first born Son, where she wrapped him in the cloths she had and placed Him in a manger.

In the same area around Bethlehem, there were shepherds watching over their flocks of sheep. While in these fields in the dark of the night, an angel of the Lord appeared to them. With the angel radiating the glory of God and standing in their midst he announced to them, "For there is born to you this day in the city of David a Savior, who is the Christ the Lord. And this will be the sign to you: You will find a Babe wrapped in swaddling clothes, lying in manger." (Luke 2:11-12) Startled and even amazed by this heavenly visitation they gathered their thoughts and wasted no time as they headed to Bethlehem to find this Savior. After reaching Bethlehem, they found Mary and Joseph, and the baby lying in a manger just as they were told. The shepherds shared their visit from the Lord's angel with Joseph and Mary and how they knew where to find them.

Vraise Reports

My uncle was diagnosed with 2 brain tumors and stage 4 lung cancer on Tuesday, Oct. 14th. The doctor decided that the first course of action was to remove one of the tumors in order to reduce the swelling on his brain. This tumor was affecting his motor skills. On Friday, Oct 18th, he had the tumor removed and when he got out of surgery he was able to speak and move all his extremities, which was a blessing. The doctor said the surgery went perfect. Saturday morning, he got up and made a phone call to his home and the nurses had him up and walking on Saturday. God gets the glory for

being present in that operating room and guiding and directing the hands of the surgeon. This was the first step in his recovery journey and God is answering prayers. He was released from the hospital on October 21st, just 3 days after brain surgery, that is truly a miracle. I just found out some more good news ... the biopsy came back on the lung cancer and it is non-small cell cancer so it is the treatable kind. In two weeks they will start chemo and radiation therapy and he will have that every day for 30 days. On October 24th, his staples were taken out and the doctor was amazed at how well he has healed. The doctor that operated on my uncle Jim had just arrived at that hospital on Monday, October 14th and it was his first surgery at the hospital. He is a doctor from John Hopkins Hospital. Foot's Bible Study Motes

1 Samuel 1:1-4:22

Hello my brothers and sisters. Like many of you I gave my life to Christ inside the wire. For me it was eight years ago and of course, like many of you, I wondered how was our Lord going to use a lifer to do His work. I worried about that for a couple of years and in that time I watched and talked with other Christians who couldn't wait to get out to start their work for the Lord. Well, I'm here to tell you that God will use you no matter where you are at and what your situation. So for me, I dug into the Word and worked on my own growth quietly, chugging along. And as I progressed and prayed for God to open my eyes to opportunities slowly at first I began to see all the blessings God blesses our world with. A couple of years go by, and the Solo newsletter was brought to my attention and I figured this is my opportunity to work for God, but my friends that was just the beginning. Now opportunities show up to me all the time. I figure that if you walk with the Lord in His joy then others can't help but notice, "Why is this guy so happy all the time, he's never getting out?" Trust me God will use you too.

Just in the past three weeks two different guys at different times came up to me asking how I was able to kick my drug problem of 20 plus years. I tell them two things: 1) I was sick and tired of drugs and everything involved with them. 2) I asked God to guide me to a life of sobriety. Now I won't push my beliefs onto anyone but the one guy must have walked three miles worth of laps while I told him of my journey to sobriety. And yes it was hard, one of the hardest things I've ever done. Yes, I had a couple of setbacks but I persevered. Basically, nothing is easy right when you start no matter what you are trying to do. How many times did you fall before mastering the art of walking? Anyhow, I was more than happy to talk with these guys about kicking habits. The second guy came to me at my cubical and spent an hour also asking about quitting drugs. Now neither of these guys was ready to accept Christ but they did seek me out to ask for help. It seems funny that if you just walk your own walk God will place opportunities in your path for you to do good works. THE MIRACLE BIRTH OF THE MESSIAH – Part II ... continued

Herod the Great is still the king in Jerusalem at this time and even more delusional than ever. Wise men, a priestly class of men thought also to be trained students of the stars, had witnessed an unexplainable brilliant star-like phenomenon in the heavens while they were yet in the East. These men were more than likely Gentiles and for some unknown reason they had interpreted this heavenly star to be a sign of the birth of the King of the Jews. Leaving a region close to Persia, and carrying with them gifts fit for this King, from the East they followed this 'seemingly moving star' until they ended up in Jerusalem. Entering Jerusalem they began asking the people where Christ the King was to be born. Herod, hearing the fuss in the city and feeling threatened, demanded that the chief priests and scribes come and inform him where exactly the Christ was to be born. Entering Herod's presence the chief priests and scribes answered, "...In Bethlehem of Judea ..." (Matthew 2:5).

This was the fulfillment of the prophesy in *Micah 5:2*, "But you, Bethlehem, in the land of Judah, Are not the least among the rulers of Judah; For out of you shall come a Ruler Who will shepherd My people Israel."

After Herod heard this, he devised what he thought to be a shrewd plan. He summoned for the wise men and told them that he knew the whereabouts of this new Child. He planned to convince the wise men that he too had intentions of worshipping this Child. Sending them away with this information Herod requested that when the wise men found the baby they return to him and let him know His exact location. Leaving Jerusalem on their five-hour journey to Bethlehem they followed the same star they had followed from the East. It led them directly to the Child. Entering the room, and being in Jesus' presence the wise men immediately fell to the floor and began worshipping Him. The wise men then rose from their worship and went to bring the gifts they had brought for Him. Taking their gifts of gold, frankincense, and myrrh, they laid them before Jesus.

The wise men were preparing to leave Joseph and Mary and return to Jerusalem to inform Herod where he might find this new Child. But before the wise men left one of them was visited in a dream and warned not to return to Herod. They defied Herod's request and went around Jerusalem and back to their homeland a different way.

At the same time as the wise men's dream, Joseph also had a dream. Joseph's dream was a warning to take Mary and the Child and flee from Herod into Egypt. In the middle of the night, Joseph put Mary and the baby Jesus on the back of their animal and headed towards Egypt. With all the wonderful gifts the wise men had just given Joseph, Mary and Jesus, it's easy to see how the rest of their journeys were financed.

In the meantime, while Herod was waiting for the wise men to return, he received a message that instead of him fooling the wise men he had become the fool. The wise men were not coming back like he had instructed them, and hearing this he went completely out of control. With all the rage of being swindled by the wise men and now not knowing the whereabouts of this new birth, Herod spun into the madman that he truly was. Herod, with his demented mind was determined to keep his throne and ordered his officers to go to Bethlehem and kill all of the babies two years old and younger. Even though this was a wicked and cruel act by Herod it fulfilled the prophesy in *Jeremiah 31:15*, "A voice was heard in Ramah, Lamentation and bitter weeping, Rachel weeping for her children, Refusing to be comforted for her children, Because they are no more."

Here's something that seems somewhat strange to me. We've seen above that the people of Israel were desperately searching and watching for a new king and savior, right? Remember, the scribes and chief priests were Jews and had the Scriptures and knew the prophesy. They only had to travel five miles from Jerusalem to Bethlehem to investigate this event. The wise men traveled all the way from the East to Jerusalem to locate this Child. Why do you suppose that is? I believe it's because the wise men seen this as the heavenly visit that it was. The Jewish people on the other hand, were more focused and concerned with their current earthly situations. In other words, the Jewish people were looking for a man to save them, causing them to miss the Man that God sent as their Savior!

Let me show you why I wrote 'seemingly moving star' several paragraph's above. We are told in *Matthew 2:9*, "When they heard the king, they departed; and behold, the star which they had seen in the East went before them, till it came and stood over where the young Child was." Note these words in *Matthew 2:16*, "... and put to death all male children ... from two years old and younger ..." Then notice that verse 9 references that the star, "... went before them, till it came and stood over ..." which should show us all that the star was evidently moving. Now, from the time the wise men began following the star from the East, until the time that Herod gave this order to put these male children to death, two years had passed. Why do I think this? Because the verses in *Matthew 2:9*, 16 just revealed it!

Some of you may not be reading your Bibles that often, (no condemnation intended) and there are some of you that don't have access to a Bible. So, even though this is another message, I know this is important to tell you now. Ever since Adam and Eve's deception by satan, God has had a plan to redeem mankind. The miracle birth of Jesus set God's plan into action here on earth. This is just the beginning of The Good News!! Jesus came to fulfill the mission and pay the price

in full for ALL mankind's sins, removing God's wrath. Jesus did fulfill His mission! This means that, GOD IS NOT MAD AT YOU!! With His last breath, hanging on the Cross He said, "Fallies, Into Your hands I contain My spirit." (Luke 23:46) He continued, in John 19:30, by saying, "It is finished?" Jesus gave up His spirit and HE IS OUR REDEEMER!!

My final prayer here today is, "That you all believe by faith and understand, that this is enough Good News to celebrate Jesus every day not only at Christmas!"
