Her dissertation was entitled *Parenting The Second Time Around: African American Custodial Grandmother’s Attachment with their Grandchildren*. Overall, her interests include grandparents raising their grandchildren, at-risk youth with problematic behaviors, working with African American Families, and integrating spirituality with mental health.
