

Math Supply List

Planner May be used for all classes to record homework, quiz, test and project dates etc.

Pencils No 2 standard or mechanical (work completed in pen will not be accepted)

Extra lead if using mechanical pencils

Erasers

3 hole punched graph paper. 3 packages (more may be needed during the year) All class notes and work not done on worksheets or quizzes or tests will be done on graph paper. Besides being used to graph, working on graph paper helps the student keep his/her work neat and problems worked in columns aligned.

1 1/2" 3 slant ring durable binder to be used **only** for math. All notes, handouts, homework, quizzes and tests etc. will be kept in this binder. (This binder will be graded periodically)

5 Pocket Dividers with tabs for the 3 ring binder

Self-adhesive standard diameter hole reinforcements

20lb white printer paper 2 reams 500 sheets each

Low odor dry erase makers and eraser Students will use mini white boards in class

Package of colored pencils and sharpener

Large Glue Stick

High Lighter (optional) to be used on notes taken in class. (***IT IS NOT TO BE USED IN THE BOOK***)

12" ruler (not flexible) with inches on one side and centimeters on the other

Protractors It is best to have both a 6" and a mini 3 1/2 – 4" these are also used in higher level classes

Compass (drafting) **Must** have a **center** wheel this will also be used in higher level math classes

Zippered pouch large enough to contain, pencils, colored pencils and sharpener, dry erase makers and eraser, protectors and compass (Larger ones can also be found at Home Depot and Lowes in the hardware section.)

BASIC MATH AND PREALGEBRA STUDENTS ONLY

TI-30X IIS 2- line calculator or equivalent (*Not MultiView!*) Each student must have their own calculator. Sharing even among siblings will not be permitted.

ALGEBRA 1, ALGEBRA 2, GEOMETRY, PRE-CAL. & BUSINESS MATH STUDENTS ONLY

TI-Nspire CX (only, NOT the CX CAS model) or TI-84 Plus CE This calculator, if taken care of will be used through all high school math classes and most college math classes. These two models are permitted on the PSAT, SAT, ACT, AP and IB exams. I strongly recommend that you purchase a

zippered calculator case to protect the calculator. It is the student's responsibility to know how to work their calculator. Each student must have their own calculator.
