Allowable Quantity Increased for Code A4606NUEP – Oxygen Probe Used W/Oximeter Disposable for ages 20 and under

Effective March 1, 2021, MO HealthNet will increase the allowed maximum quantity of procedure code A4606NUEP, oxygen probes used with the disposable oximeter to 10 per month. The Certificate of Medical necessity must be retained in the participant's file.
