See everyone at the next meeting. We are going to check out a collection of old Ford trucks!



If you go directly to Rod Kruithof's from the north: take M45 (Lake Michigan Drive) to either 96th Ave. or 120th Ave. and turn south to Stanton (just south of Filmore St.) Go to 10910 Stanton (south side of the road).
