Communication is Key: We do our best to communicate with our Parents about special events and dates. PLEASE make sure you check the mailboxes, e-mails, messages on the check in station, outside board, and papers we post on the doors and near the check in station to stay informed.

REVIEWING POLICIES:

- ANNUAL REGISTRATION DUE:** This registration fee will help us with supplies and help make our school better. Annual registration will be added to accounts over the next 6 weeks with a charge of \$30 every 2 weeks, although you may pay the full \$90 anytime during the 6 weeks.
- PAYMENTS:** Tuition is due on Fridays for the upcoming week the children will be attending.
- LATE PAYMENTS:** Any accounts with a balance on Friday at 5:30 pm will be subject to our late payment fee of **\$15**, as stated on the Parent Handbook.
- VACATION:** If your child will be on Vacation for an entire week we will charge a **\$40** spot hold fee in place of your Tuition Rate as a courtesy.
- WITHDRAWAL:** A two-week written notice is required for all children enrolled in a full-time, part-time, Preschool, or VPK only program. Please note that if you chose to leave without giving us the 2 weeks' notice you will still be in charge of paying the tuition for those 2 weeks.

SUMMER CAMP: We are hosting weekly in- house field trips for school-age, VPK, and our VPK Risers so please see front office for details. We also will be doing a few away field trips throughout the month. We are keeping in mind the health and safety of our students and staff as we take extra precautions when planning field trips due to Covid-19. Be sure to check our website or the front office to view the calendars for a look at the activities, events, and trips planned.

MUFFINS FOR MOM/DOUGHNUTS FOR DAD: These last few months have been a bit hectic for our community. We want to ensure we make time to acknowledge our parents who love and care for our little bees' day in and day out. We will be having "Muffins for Mom" and "Doughnuts for Dad" on Friday June 19th during drop off. To honor social distancing, we will have a grab and go muffin or donut for moms and dads to grab during drop off and BFF will take a quick picture of you and your child before you leave. Your child will have a doughnut or muffin for breakfast in their classroom for breakfast as well.

FREE VPK: If your child or someone you know will be 4 years old prior to September 1st, 2020 they are invited to join our fall VPK program which we are now enrolling for! This program is a free preschool program for 3 hours a day. If you require a full day program, we have discounted tuition rates available. Please see a member of admin for more details.

READING IS FUNDAMENTAL: Read to your child for at least 20 minutes a day. Research shows it will help improve vocabulary comprehension and listening skills and will likely make a child a better reader as well. During the winter break make it a priority to read with your children every day.

You may request your country to be celebrated, come in and share facts/food/stories about your culture, or even read a story about your country.
