PAYOUT

- Grocery Getter Feature – \$1000, \$500, \$300, \$200, \$150, \$90, \$80, \$70, \$60, \$50
- Trailer Figure 8 – \$500, \$300, \$200, \$150, \$100

SIGN-UPS

- Participants will sign-up for events in the garage attached to the pit office.
- Paying to get into the pit area is your entry fee.
- You may participate in multiple events. Sign up separately for each.

TRANSPONDER & POUCH

- These are required for the Grocery Getters. NOT THE TRAILER FIGURE 8!
- Transponder rental fee is \$10 each. A driver's license will be held until its return.
- The orange Westhold transponder pouch is required. Please bring your previously purchased pouch to use. New pouches will be available for \$25 each.
- Pouches with transponder inside must be securely closed and mounted with zip ties under the rear "axle" with the transponder silver side down.
- Transponders and pouches will be available in the garage attached to the pit office.

VEHICLE BUILD RULES

OVERALL

- A. Preparation – All vehicles must come to the track RACE READY. Removing glass and debris on Speedrome property will result in being asked to leave without refund.
- B. Fuel Tank – Stock fuel tank in stock location only.
- C. Glass – All glass, headlights, and taillights must be removed except for the front windshield.
- D. Sunroof – It must be removed, and the opening fully covered by steel.
- E. Interior – All interior must remain in stock condition including seats.
- F. Debris – ALL excess loose items must be removed such as glass, jack, spare tire, trash, etc.
- G. Seatbelts – Must have working factory seatbelts and must be used AT ALL TIMES while on track.
- H. Doors – Must be fastened, chained, or welded shut.
- I. Reinforcement – The only added reinforcements allowed are an outside steel bar or steel door plate on the driver's door. No roll cages.
- J. Airbags – Must be removed.
- K. Exhaust – Must remain stock and stock sounding with a working muffler. Catalytic converter may be removed but must be fully replaced with exhaust pipe.

- L. Tires – Regular Street DOT tires are required. No High performance/racing tires or slicks. No run-flats. When tires go flat, you pull off the track. Track has final say.
- M. Numbers – Car numbers must be big, bold and EASY TO READ with a simple font. Must be on both sides and on the roof. Adding single letters is recommended with the high car count. Track may ask you to add a letter if needed.
- N. Overall – These are NOT intended to be race cars, just a way to have fun. All tech and track decisions towards eligibility are final.

DRIVER & PASSENGER EQUIPMENT

- A. Must wear long sleeves and long pants (fire suit recommended).
- B. Neck collar is required.
- C. Must wear a helmet that is clearly labeled to meet or exceed the 2010 SA Snell or SFI 31.2 standard. Helmet must be worn at all times while on track (including while parked in the infield).

AFTER THE EVENT

- A. It is your responsibility to take your vehicle back with you. The track will have equipment to help you load immediately after the final event is complete (equipment not available during the week).
- B. Additional removal time is available for pick up the Monday & Tuesday after the event between 10am-4pm. We are not responsible for what happens to your vehicle if left after the event night.

GROCERY GETTER

- A. Eligible Vehicles – 4 & 6 cylinder cars, small SUV's, and minivans with a maximum of 22' in length. No 4WD or AWD or full size vehicles. No trucks. No convertibles.
- B. Passengers – A single front seat passenger is allowed. Must be a minimum of 18 years of age. Must wear the same safety equipment as listed in the driver equipment section. Track has final say.

TRAILER FIGURE 8

- A. Eligible Towing Vehicles – Must be a passenger car, minivan, or small 2-wheel or 4-wheel drive truck/SUV. No convertibles.
- B. Occupant Protection – Door must be covered on the outside with a minimum 1/8" thick steel plate that encompasses the "A" and "B" pillars. Plate must be a minimum of 12" in height.
- C. Eligible Trailers – Light duty trailers only. The trailer must have been street legal at one time. No converted pickup bed box trailers. Pop up campers are allowed. If hauling a boat, you MUST take the boat back home with you. Track has final approval.
- D. Passengers – A single front seat passenger is allowed. Must be a minimum of 18 years of age. Must wear the same safety equipment as listed in the driver equipment section. Must have the same occupant protection as listed above. Track has final say.
