Scholarship applicants,

Carmel United Soccer Club has sponsored the Christopher Tompkins Memorial Tournament, as well as other fundraising events, to establish scholarship funds for graduating seniors involved in the Club. This year we are able to offer scholarships to the graduating class of 2022. As a graduating senior involved with the Club, you may be eligible to receive a scholarship. The selection committee is now accepting written applications for consideration. The amount of the scholarship has ranged between \$200 and \$250 in the past depending on the number of qualified applicants.

The criteria for consideration are as follows:

1. Applicant must be an active 2021-2022 member of the Carmel United Soccer Club as a player, coach, or referee. If there is not a viable team for the applicant to play on for the 2021-2022 season, the applicant must have at one time played within the club. Proof of this must be indicated in your essay.
2. Applicant must live in the Carmel Central School District.
3. Applicant must have a B average or better for his/her senior year and must provide a copy of a current report card with grade point average and rank in class signed by your guidance counselor.
4. Applicant must graduate by June 2022 and plan to attend a school of higher education.
5. Applicant must submit a 250 word essay on his/her goals for the future and include how the club and the sport of soccer has affected their lives.
6. Applicant must be available for a personal interview at the discretion of the committee.
