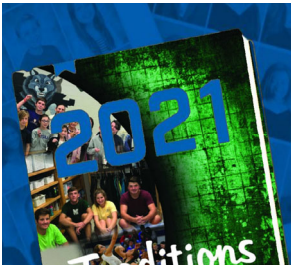

PART OF THE PACK OR FLYING SOLO?



Maurepas third graders took a walk on the wild side, learning about animal adaptations for survival that is! After learning about how animals live in the wild, Mrs. Jamie Rodriguez's third grade science students had to make a big decision.....did they want to be a member of a group or try to survive on their own? Their task was to collect doubloons- three blue representing water, two green representing food, and one bronze representing shelter.

With a ratio of about half the students in groups and half working individually, the students darted around the auditorium collecting coins in 30 second intervals. If a group or individual did not collect the necessary doubloons, they had to sit out for a round. One group specialized by assigning collection of a certain color doubloon to each group member. Students collected doubloons in this race for survival for about six rounds with those working in groups having the best survival rate. Maurepas third graders proved that perhaps being a member of the Wolf Pack has its advantages!
