THE APARTMENT

Situated on the highest floor of a 19th century freestone building just steps away from the river Seine at Pont Neuf - the oldest bridge along the Seine. Bathed in light, the apartment offers a clear vista of the surrounding roof-tops and magnificent monuments. The Eglise Saint Eustache, Sacré Coeur at Montmartre and Saint Sulpice are all in view along with the statue of Henry IV on Pont Neuf, right in the middle of the beautiful Seine. Nightfall presents you with a spectacle of the top of the glittering Eiffel Tower whilst you are enjoying your evening meal in the dining room or sipping a cocktail on the sofa. An elevator brings you up to this 75 m2 (800 ft2) apartment beautifully decorated with period furniture and artwork. Many interesting cafes, restaurants and shops await your discovery in the vicinity and a few minutes' stroll will bring you to the Louvre and other Parisian attractions.

LAYOUT OF APARTMENT

Living/Dining Room

Relax in the spacious living/dining area with beautiful views out of the windows or be entertained by more than 100 cable channels on your flat screen HDTV including English channels such as CNN, BBC World, Skynews, etc. Dock your iPhone or iPod on the stereo sound system to enjoy your favourite music while you reflect on the day's outing or plan the next exciting visit. The high quality sofa bed in the living room has a thick double bed mattress which can sleep 2 adults comfortably.

Two Bedrooms

GETTING AROUND

Walk

Rue de Rivoli (1 min), one of the major shopping streets of Paris.

Seine river at Pont Neuf (3 min) where you can board your Seine river cruise boat tour.

RER/Metro Châtelet - Les Halles station (2 min) where you can catch the **train direct to Charles de Gaulle Airport and Orly Airport.**

Musée de Louvre (6 min) to admire Leonardo da Vinci's Mona Lisa.

Georges Pompidou Centre (8 min) which houses the Musée National d'Art Moderne, the largest museum for modern art in Europe.

Jardin du Palais Royal (10 min), a peaceful garden oasis in the middle of the city.

The beautiful **Tuileries Gardens** (12 min) and **The Orangerie** (where you can admire Claude Monet's water lilies).

Along the Seine river bank to the Notre Dame Cathedral (13 mins).

Musée d'Orsay (20 min) which houses the largest collection of impressionist and post-impressionist masterpieces in the world.

Along the broad Avenue de l'Opera to the **Opera Garnier** (22 min) of The Phantom of the Opera fame.

Along the shopping street of Rue Saint-Honore to Place Vendome (18 min).

Bus

From the bus stop at the junction of Rue du Pont Neuf and Rue de Rivoli, take:

Line 72 to Trocadero/Pont d'Iena to view the Eiffel Tower in all its splendour

Lines 21 and 81 to **Opera Garnier** and the "grands magasins" – the big department stores of **Galeries Lafayette and Printemps**

Line 58 to the chic Saint-Germain des Pres and Jardin du Luxembourg on the left bank

Line 67 to Pigalle for your Montmartrobus to the Sacré Coeur at Montmartre.

Metro/RER

From the Forum Les Halles Metro/RER hub, take:

Line 1 to Champs Elysees and La Defense

Line 14 to Place Madeleine and Gare Saint-Lazare

Line 4 to the famous **Marches aux Puces** antiques market and Gare du Nord where you catch the **Eurostar** train

Line 7 to Galeries Lafayette and Printemps on Boulevard Haussmann and Gare de l'Est

RER A to **Disneyland** (Marne la-Vallee)

RER B to Charles de Gaulle Airport and Orly Airport

LOCATION

The distinct advantage of staying here is its superb location allowing you to walk to many Parisian attractions. Several bus stops or metro stations literally steps from your apartment will bring you direct to many tourist destinations without the need for a transfer or change of transport. Shopping is on your door step along Rue de Rivoli and Rue Saint-Honore all the way to Place Vendome. Nearby amenities and services include SNCF boutique to book your rail tickets, post office, bank cash withdrawal machines, supermarket, boulangeries for your croissants and pastries, liquor store for French wine and champagne, pharmacy, Velib bike rental (free use of bicycles around the city), public carpark and florists.

Many famous historical French restaurants and cafes are within 5 minutes walk. All this information is detailed in the house book provided by the owner.
