



December 27, 2015 The Holy Family of Jesus, Mary and Joseph Luke 2:41-52

Jesus was sitting in the midst of the teachers, listening to them and asking them questions, and all who heard him were astounded at his understanding and his answers.

On Christmas we celebrated the Birth of Jesus. Now St. Luke tells us of the journey of Jesus as a young boy to the great city of Jerusalem to celebrate the Passover. With Joseph and Mary, their family and friends, including children his age, Jesus traveled from Nazareth in a caravan and shared the rigors and dangers for the three days of the trip; making camp each night, cooking food, telling stories and protecting themselves. There would have been many groups like them camped in the hills around Jerusalem. After the Feast, the groups returned home. Jesus, who would have played games with the other children on the way to Jerusalem, was attracted to the teachers who had studied the Law of Moses for many years and taught in the Temple precincts. The were amazed by the wisdom of such a young boy, and the depth of his understanding of the God of all Creation. When Joseph and Mary returned to find Jesus in the Temple, they chided him for staying behind in his Father's house. And so must we.
