



The hardest job you never applied for...



And if the deceased didn't plan it ahead of time, just be prepared for some interesting challenges as you now have to find a location, arrange all the details for the funeral, while the spouse, kids or even friends might all have a different opinion on how and where it should be done.



Again, by simply discussing and encouraging the testator (person who wrote the will) to pre-plan the funeral can save you a huge amount of headaches when the time comes. Everything can be organized ahead of time, it can even be fully paid by the deceased, which will leave you with the task of simply implementing what was already decided long ago.

Have you ever wondered how you can save your texts in a format that allows you to navigate them easily? I encourage you to check the program called [CopyTrans Control Center](#).



I used CopyTrans Contact to download all the texts from my phone onto my computer. It made me realize how many texts I had been accumulating over the years and was still carrying on my phone: over 67,000... no need to say that I've cleaned it up since, and got rid of a whole lot of old messages knowing that should I need them, they're safely stored in my dropbox folder.
