Ways To Get Involved

Great Barrier Relief

The Great Barrier Relief works to identify creative and innovative opportunities to assist people in their reentry. This group examines barriers people face and combats those challenges. There are workgroups focusing on improving prosocial activities, housing and employment options.

Healing Communities

Healing Communities coordinates with the faith community to implement the Healing Communities Model in local churches interested in supporting individuals reentering the community and families effected by loved ones incarcerated and/or exiting the corrections system.

Outreach

This committee educates the community about the barriers, needs, and successes of individuals transitioning back into the community. The committee oversees marketing materials, social media, webpage development, resource guides, reentry simulations and community presentations.

Case Review

The purpose of this team is to problem solve barriers and create systemic change. Reentry cases are reviewed to identify how to best assist the individual in transition from incarceration back into the community.

Sustainability Committee

This committee is tasked with solidifying the Coalition as an anchor in our community. The group focuses on maintaining diverse funding sources, evaluation of programming and financial strategic planning.

Executive Committee

The Executive Committee is the steering and oversight committee for Franklin Together with the primary responsibility of overseeing strategic planning. Membership includes chairs, and representatives from the community, courts/reentry, employment, returning citizens, county government, corrections, members of the faith based community.
