Currently we have a total of 457 members. Not all of these members pay dues. Those who are over 65 years of age (as of the billing date for the membership cards), and have paid dues for at least 25 consecutive years with no interruptions are Honorary Life Members. An Honorary Life member pays no dues. Those members who have been paying dues for at least 25 consecutive years with no interruptions, and are under 65 years of age (again, based on the billing date) are Honorary Members and only pay \$14.50. All others are Regular members and their dues are \$50.00.

A certain portion of the dues go to the Supreme Council and State Council. There are some members who, from time to time, will make a donation to the council to help a Brother Knight, or to defray costs. These are always unexpected and most welcome.

The Columbian coat of arms (shown above) consists solely of straight lines and angles.

They are meant to symbolize to us the determination, tenacity, firmness, and courage that the Order's founders had to demonstrate in order to surmount and defend both their faith, and their rights, in the face of anti-Catholic sentiment as well as discrimination: both in the workplace and at home.

The Colors

The blue (azure), represents the sky, that is, God who watches over the world. It is the symbol of hope, peace, and confidence.

The white (silver) is innocence, frankness and purity of intention.

The yellow (gold) denotes indestructible goods, the richness that comes with hard work.

The red symbolizes giving of one's self, courage, valor and heroism in the fight for one's faith, one's language and one's rights.


