Membership in the American Legion Auxiliary (ALA) is open to female veterans and to the mothers, wives, sisters, daughters, granddaughters or great granddaughters of American Legion members or deceased veterans who served in the Armed Forces during World Wars I and II, the Korean War, the Vietnam War, Granada, Panama, and/or Lebanon conflicts, and the Persian Gulf War during the following dates:

Gulf War/War on Terrorism Panama Lebanon and Grenada Vietnam War Korean War WW II WW I August 2, 1990 to date of cessation December 20, 1989 - January 31, 1990 August 24, 1982 - July 31, 1984 February 28, 1961 - May 7, 1975 June 25, 1950 - January 31, 1955 December 7, 1941 - December 31, 1946 April 6, 1917 - November 11, 1918

Our Mission Statement is: In the spirit of Service, Not Self, the mission of the American Legion Auxiliary is to support The American Legion and to honor the sacrifice of those who serve by enhancing the lives of our veterans, military, and their families, both at home and abroad. For God and Country, we advocate for veterans, educate our citizens, mentor youth, and promote patriotism, good citizenship, peace and security.

- 2. Supply a photocopy of the American Legion member's card on which you are applying or a copy of the veteran's military form DD-214/Discharge Papers if deceased veteran.
- 3. Supply a photocopy of your current driver's license or voter registration card.
- 4. Supply a \$25.00 check for annual dues.
- 5. Return all items to: American Legion Auxiliary Unit 245 Membership Steward 1950 Pine Hall Road State College, PA 16801

Membership cards will be mailed to you following approval of your application at the monthly meeting of The Auxiliary. If you are under age 21, your Post Home Association card will be marked MINOR.
